Exodus 2:1–10

2 Now a man of the tribe of Levi married a Levite woman, 2 and she became pregnant and gave birth to a son. When she saw that he was a fine child, she hid him for three months.

3 But when she could hide him no longer, she got a papyrus basket for him and coated it with tar and pitch. Then she placed the child in it and put it among the reeds along the bank of the Nile. 4 His sister stood at a distance to see what would happen to him.

5 Then Pharaoh's daughter went down to the Nile to bathe, and her attendants were walking along the riverbank. 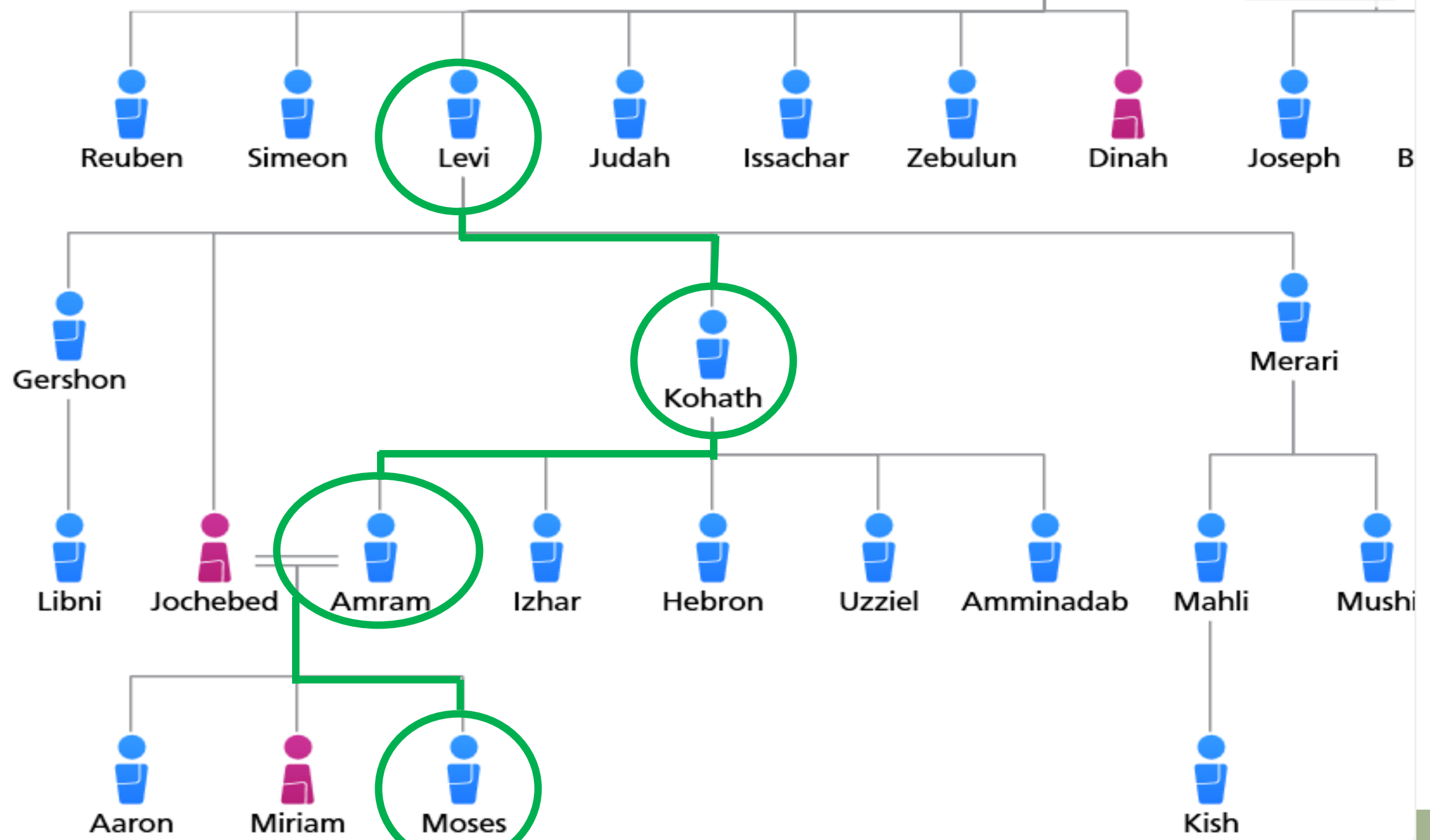

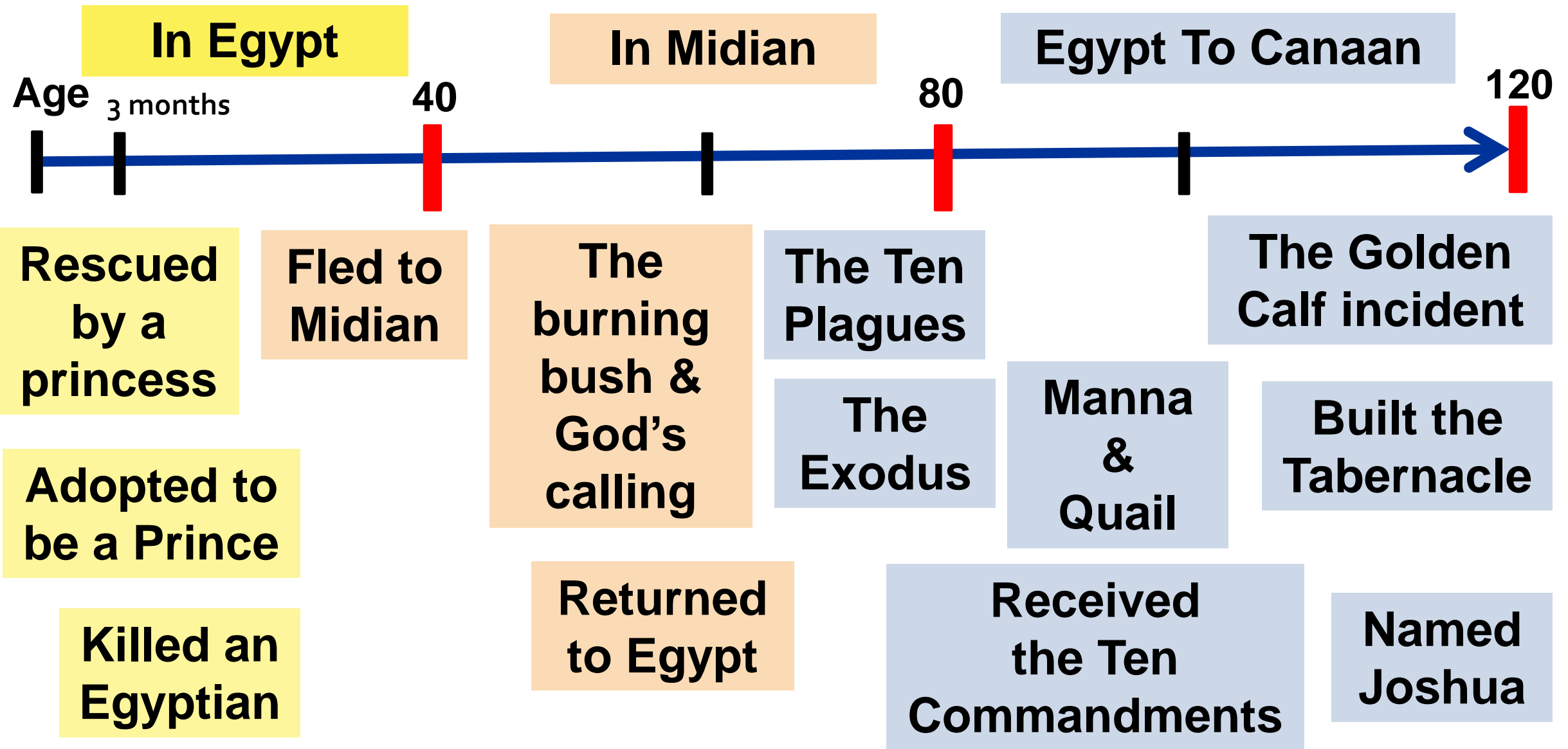

Family Tree: Levi (son of Jacob)

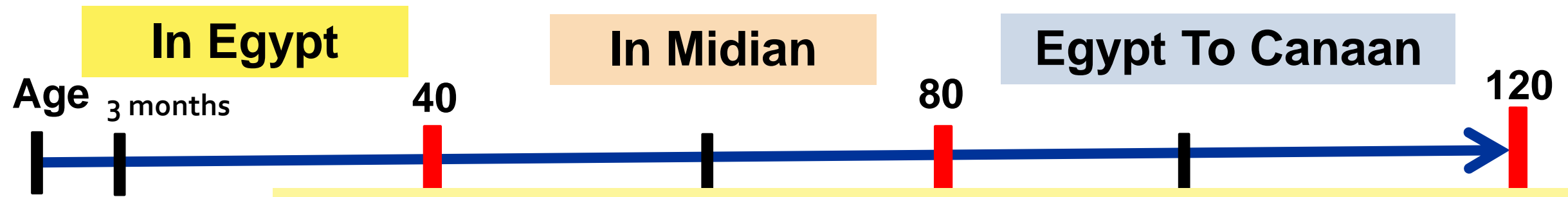

The Ten Plagues of Egypt

- 1. WATER TO BLOOD:** The waters of the Nile turned to blood.
- 2. FROGS:** Frogs infested the land of Egypt.
- 3. GNATS:** Small stinging insects infested the land of Egypt.
- 4. FLIES:** Swarms of flies, infested the land of Egypt.
- 5. PLAGUE:** A serious disease... infested the cattle of Egyptians.
- 6. BOILS:** A skin disease infected the Egyptians.
- 7. HAIL:** A storm that destroyed the grain fields of Egypt but spared the land of Goshen inhabited by the Israelites.
- 8. LOCUSTS:** An infestation of locusts stripped the land of Egypt of plant life.
- 9. DARKNESS:** A deep darkness covered the land... for three days.
- 10. DEATH OF THE FIRSTBORN:** Those of every Egyptian family died.

“The LORD’s Passover” (Ex 12:1–14)



“The LORD said ...This month is to be... the first month of your year. each man is to take a lamb for his family... 7 Then ...take some of the blood and put it on...the doorframes of the houses. 8 That same night they are to eat the meat ... it is the LORD’s Passover.

12 ...I will pass through Egypt and strike down every firstborn ...13 The blood will be a sign for you... where you are... I will pass over you. 14... for the generations to come you shall celebrate it as a festival to the LORD”
