Leviticus 23:1–8

1 The LORD said to Moses, 2 “Speak to the Israelites and say to them: ‘These are my appointed festivals, the appointed festivals of the LORD, which you are to proclaim as sacred assemblies. 3 “ ‘There are six days when you may work, but the seventh day is a day of sabbath rest, a day of sacred assembly. You are not to do any work; wherever you live, it is a sabbath to the LORD. 4 “ ‘These are the LORD’s appointed festivals, the sacred assemblies you are to proclaim at their appointed times:

Leviticus 23:1–8

5 The LORD's Passover begins at twilight on the fourteenth day of the first month. 6 On the fifteenth day of that month the LORD's Festival of Unleavened Bread begins; for seven days you must eat bread made without yeast. 7 On the first day hold a sacred assembly and do no regular work. 8 For seven days present a food offering to the LORD. And on the seventh day hold a sacred assembly and do no regular work.'

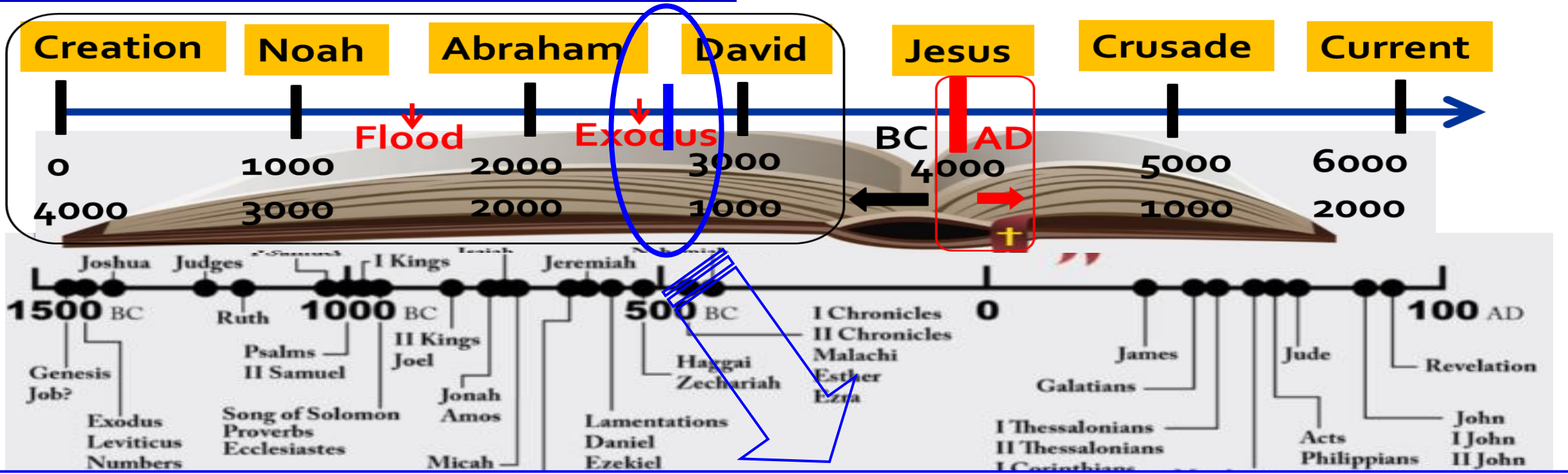

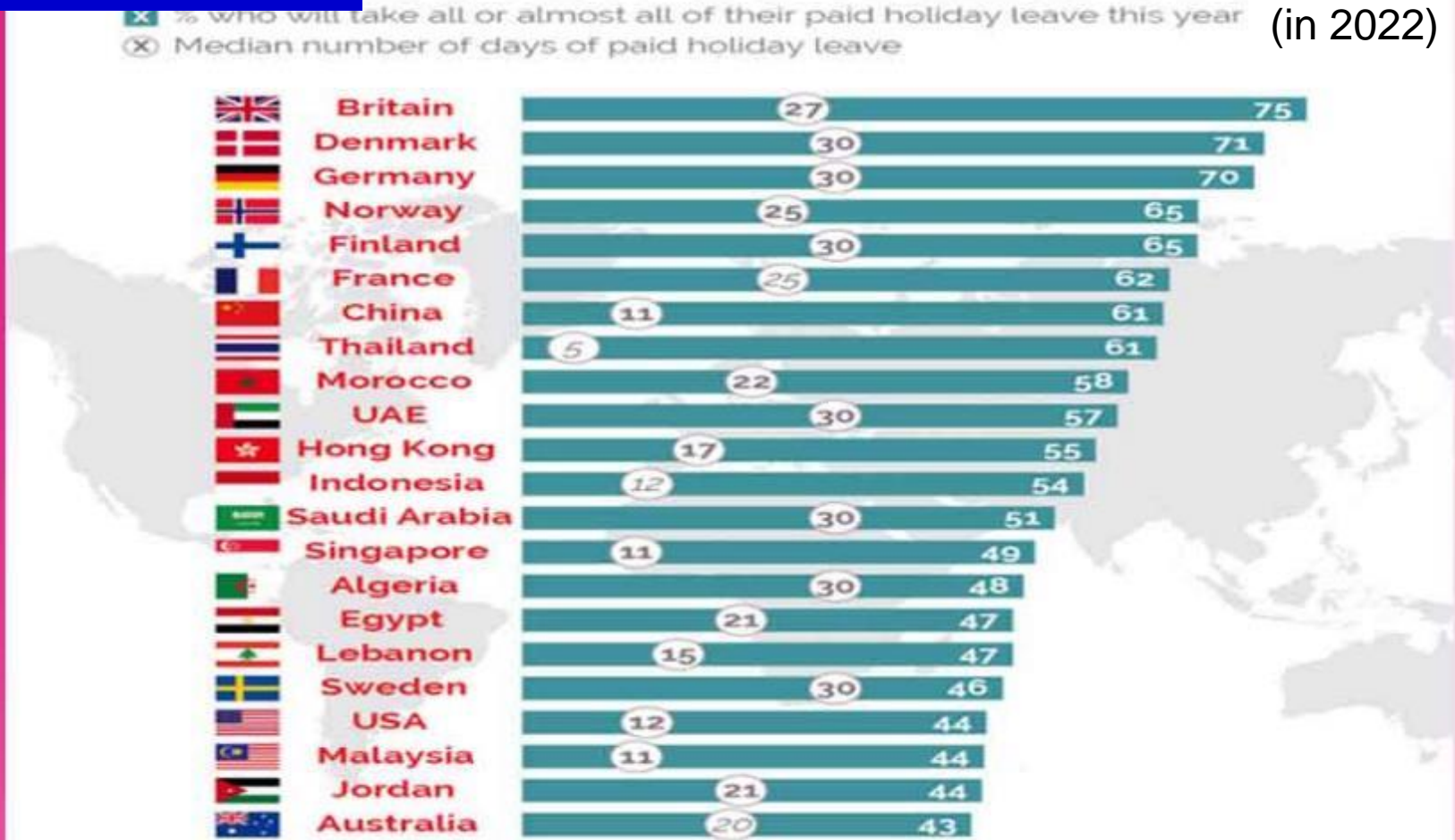

Different Countries and Paid Public Holidays

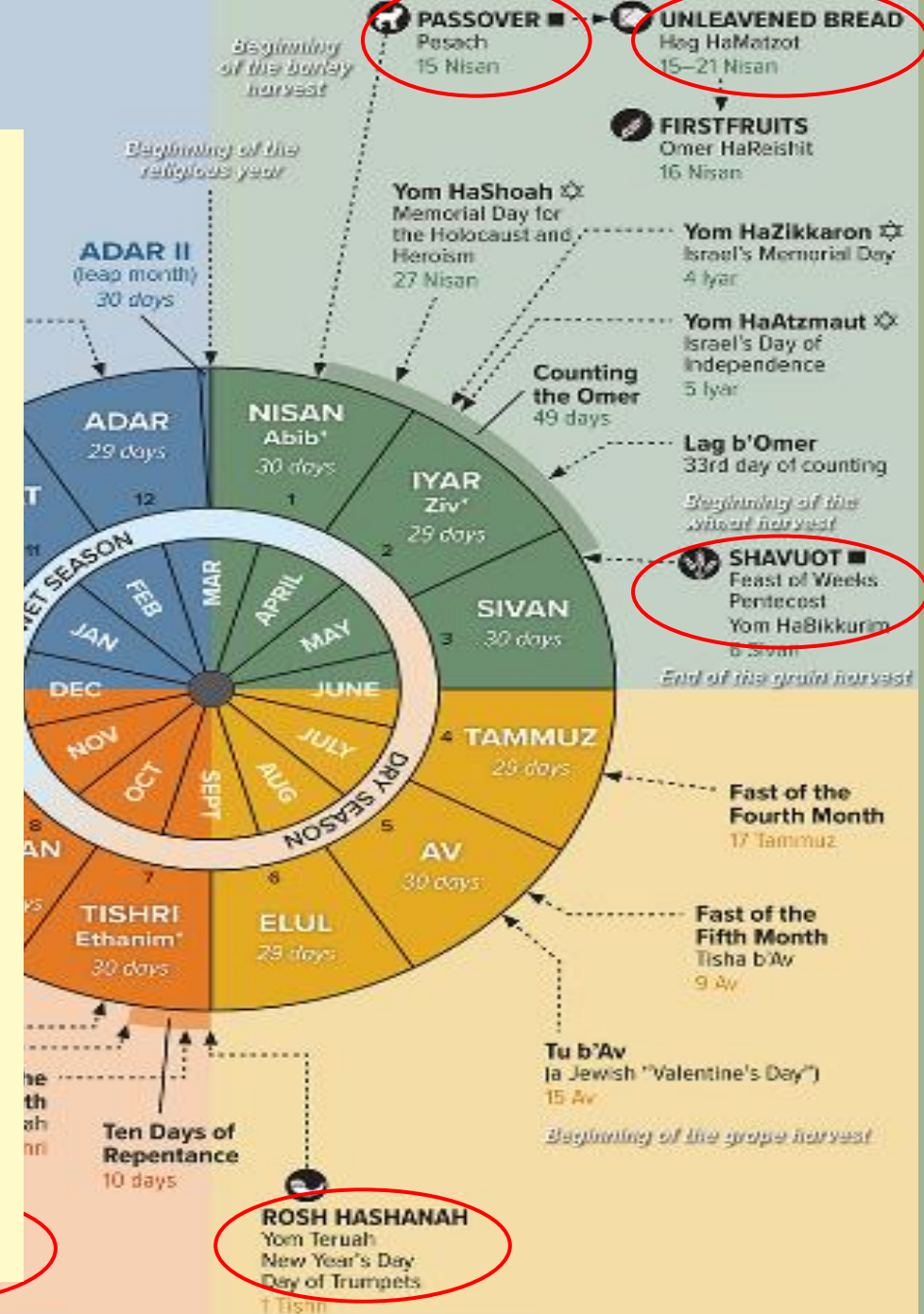

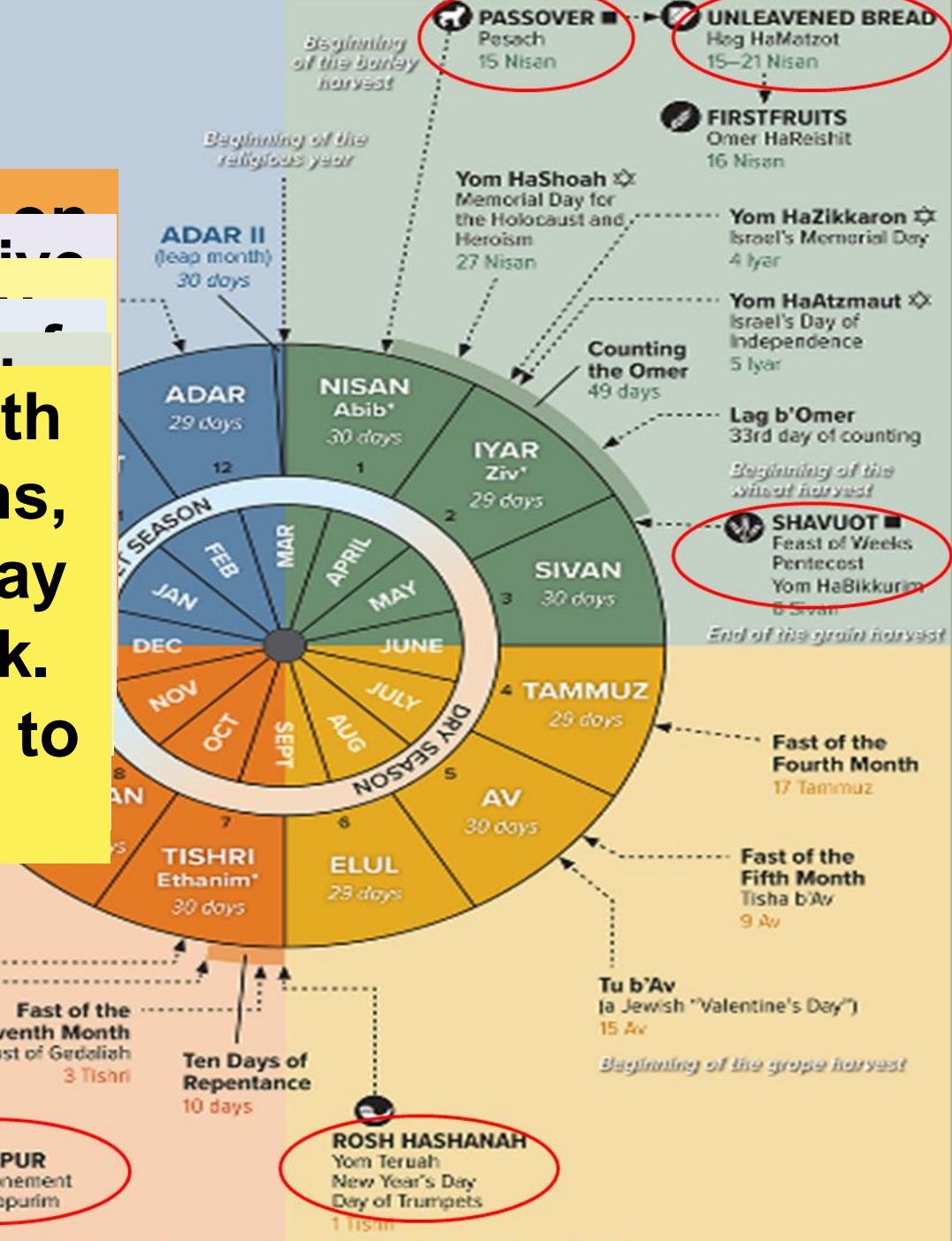

A Nation, set apart...

“The LORD said to Moses, 2 “Speak to the entire assembly of Israel ... ‘Be holy because I, the LORD your God, am holy”

-Le 19:1–2-

“23 You must not live according to the customs of the nations I am going to drive out before you.

Because they did all these things, I abhorred them...

25 ...Do not defile yourselves by any animal or bird or anything ...

26 You are to be holy to me because I, the LORD, am holy...”

Feast... Why?

Appointed by God

“...Moses and Aaron went to Pharaoh ...“This is what the LORD, the God of Israel, says: ‘Let my people go, so that they may hold a festival to me in the wilderness”

-Ex 5:1-

A Joyful Response

“This is what the LORD Almighty says: “The fasts of the fourth, fifth, seventh and tenth months will become joyful and glad occasions and happy festivals for Judah. Therefore love truth and peace” -Zec 8:19-

Feast... How?

“In addition to what you vow and your freewill offerings, offer these to the LORD at your appointed festivals: your burnt offerings, grain offerings, drink offerings and fellowship offerings.”

-Nu 29:39-

“At the feasts and the appointed festivals, the grain offering is to be an ephah with a bull, an ephah with a ram, and with the lambs...” -Eze 46:11-

But Not All...

“Your New Moon feasts and your appointed festivals I hate with all my being.” -Is 1:14-

“... Does the LORD delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as much as in obeying the LORD? To obey is better than sacrifice...” -1 Sa 15:22-

“For I desire mercy, not sacrifice, and acknowledgment of God rather than burnt offerings” -Ho 6:6-

“...with regard to a religious festival... 17 These are a shadow of the things that were to come; the reality, however, is found in Christ”

-Col 2:16–17-

“So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God” -1 Cor 10:31-
