Numbers 1:1–4

1 The LORD spoke to Moses in the tent of meeting in the Desert of Sinai on the first day of the second month of the second year after the Israelites came out of Egypt. He said: 2 “Take a census of the whole Israelite community by their clans and families, listing every man by name, one by one. 3 You and Aaron are to count according to their divisions all the men in Israel who are twenty years old or more and able to serve in the army. 4 One man from each tribe, each of them the head of his family, is to help you.

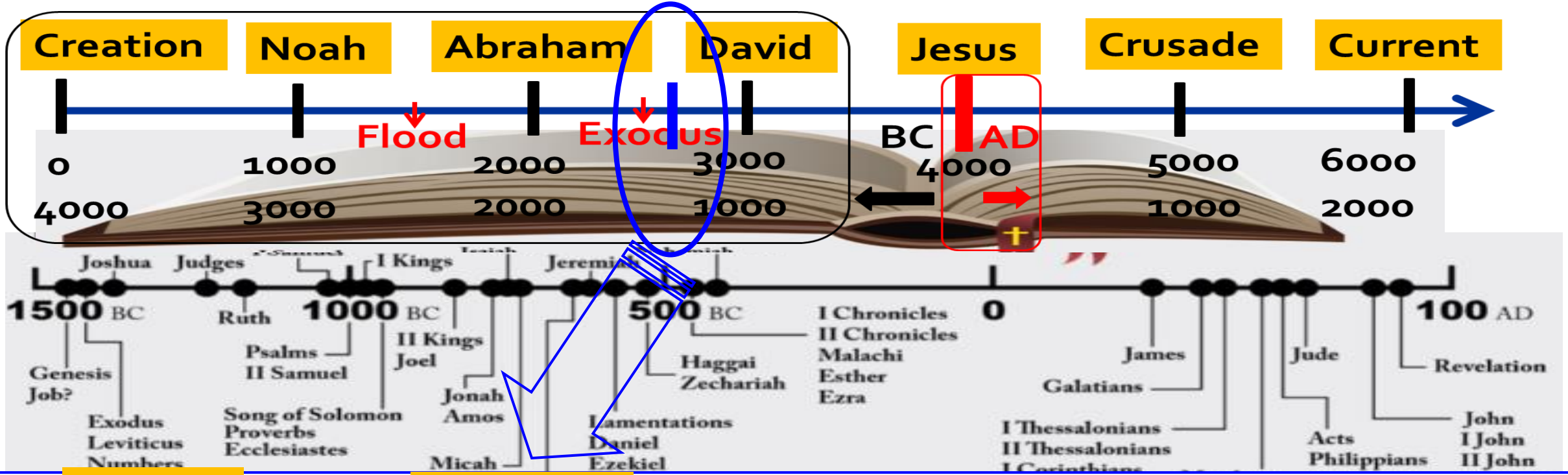

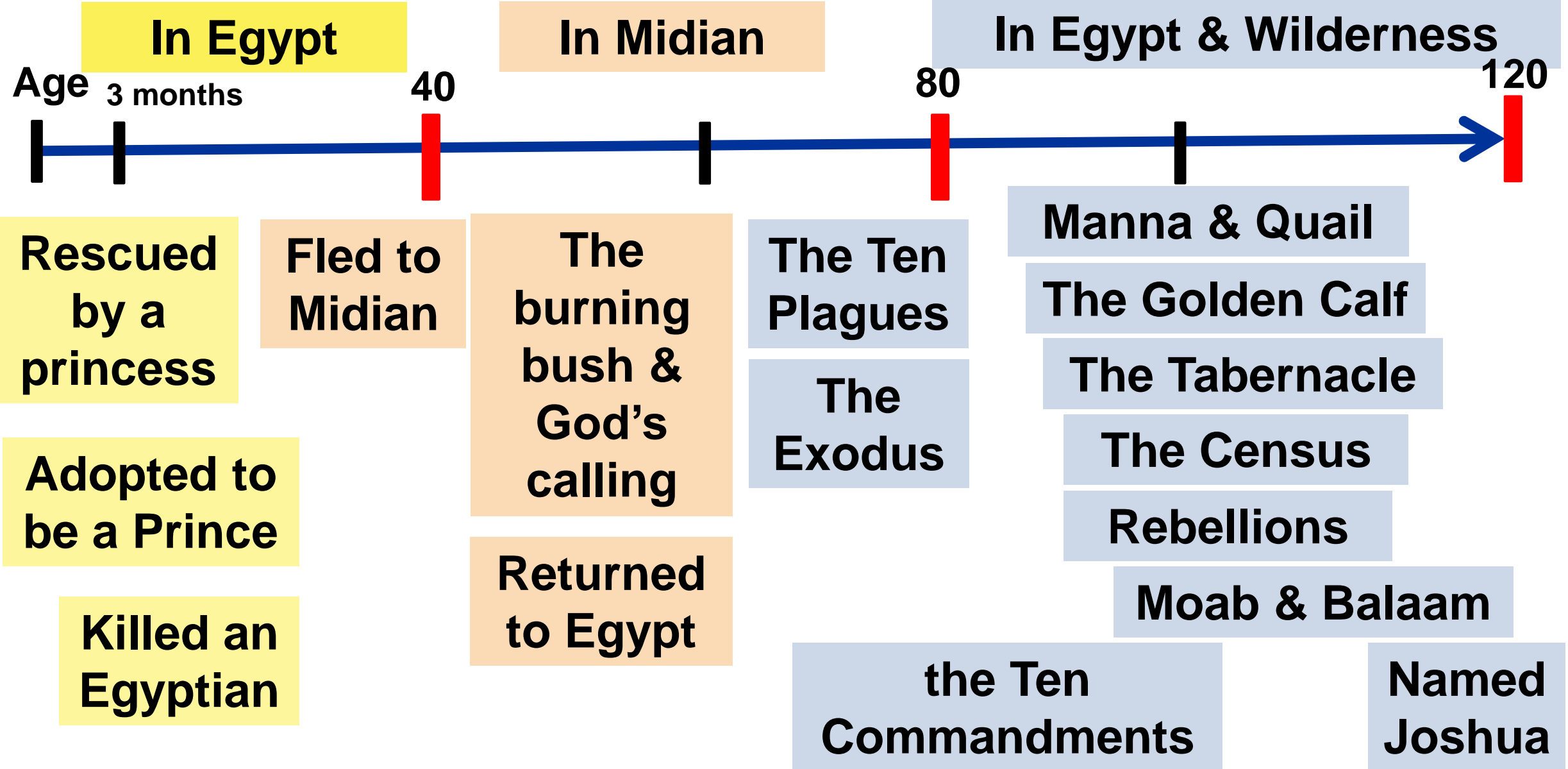

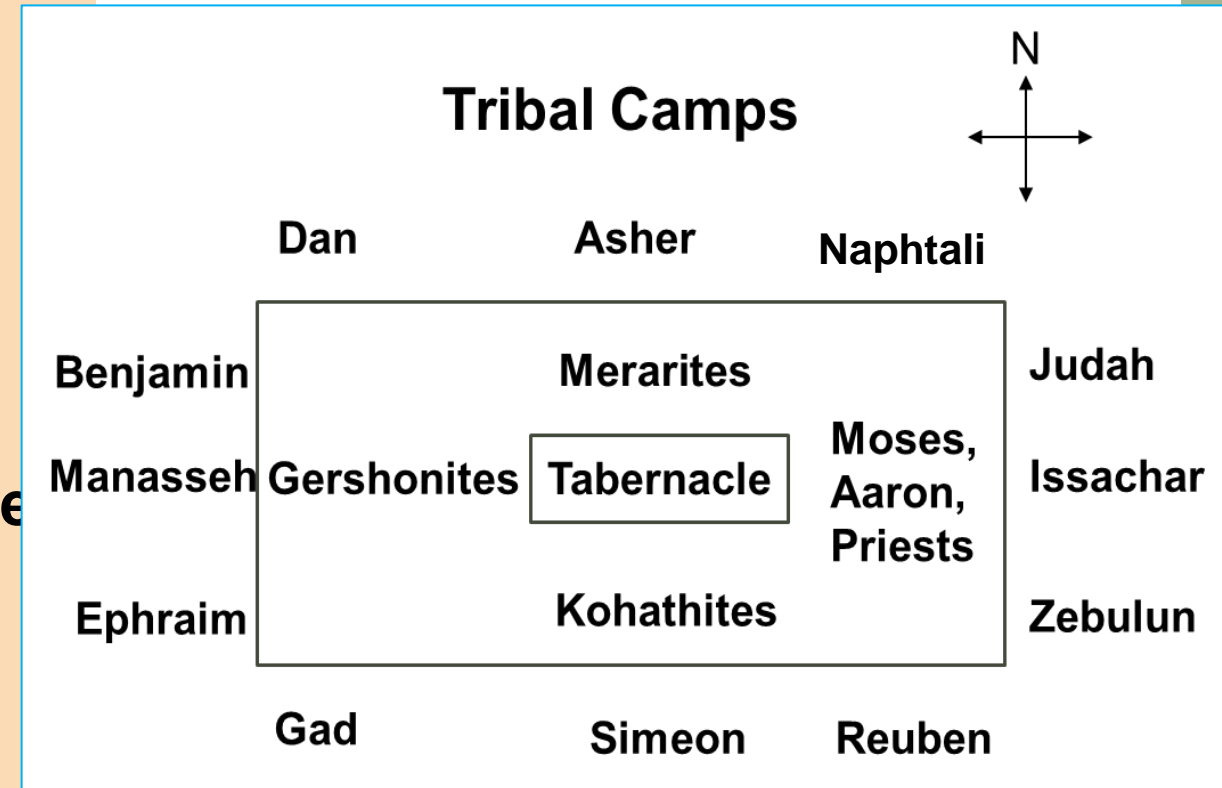

The Census...

“These are the names of the men ...:
from Reuben, Elizur son of Shedeur;
6 from Simeon...
7 from Judah...
8 from Issachar...
9 from Zebulun...
10 from the sons of Joseph...
All the Israelites twenty years old or more
who were able to serve in Israel’s army were
counted according to their families...The
total number was 603,550.
...The LORD had said ...49 “You must not
count the tribe of Levi ...Instead, appoint the
Levites to be in charge of the tabernacle of
the covenant law” -Nu 1:5–50-



The Blessing...

22 The LORD said to Moses, 23 “Tell Aaron and his sons, ‘This is how you are to bless the Israelites. Say to them:

24 “The LORD bless you and keep you;

**25 the LORD make his face shine on you
and be gracious to you;**

**26 the LORD turn his face toward you
and give you peace.”**

27 “So they will put my name on the Israelites, and I will bless them.” -Num 6:22–27-

**“When Moses finished setting up the tabernacle, he anointed and consecrated it ...the leaders of Israel ...made offerings”
-Num 7:1–2-**

“When Moses entered the tent of meeting to speak with the LORD, he heard the voice speaking to him from between the two cherubim above the atonement cover on the ark ... In this way the LORD spoke to him” -Num 7:89-

“15 On the day the tabernacle... was set up, the cloud covered it. From evening till morning the cloud above the tabernacle looked like fire... Whenever the cloud lifted from above the tent, the Israelites set out...” -Num 9:15–17-

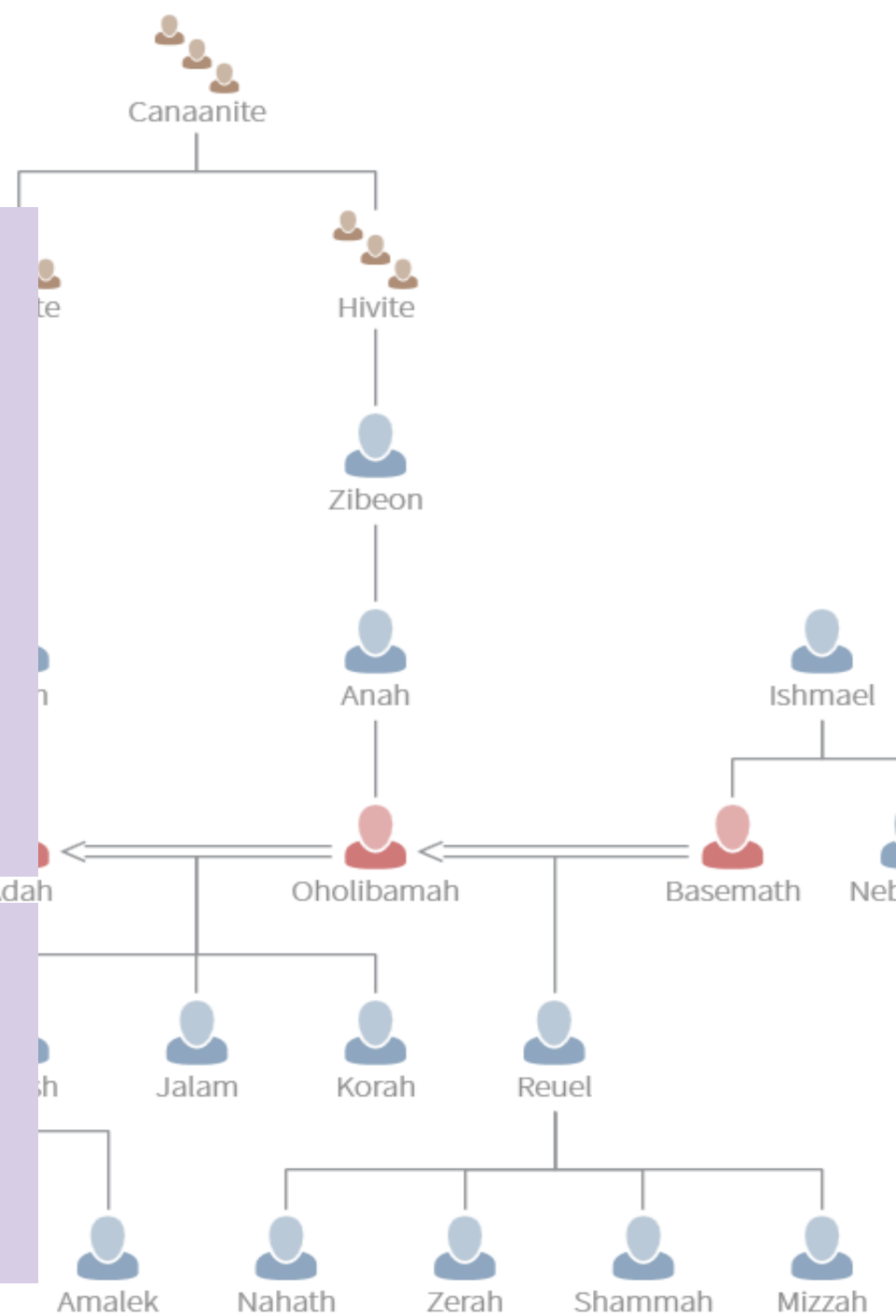
In the Promised Land...

“...go up to the land I promised on oath to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, ...I will ...drive out the Canaanites, Amorites, Hittites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites. 3 Go up to the land flowing with milk and honey...”

-Ex 33:1-3-

-Num 13:28-29-



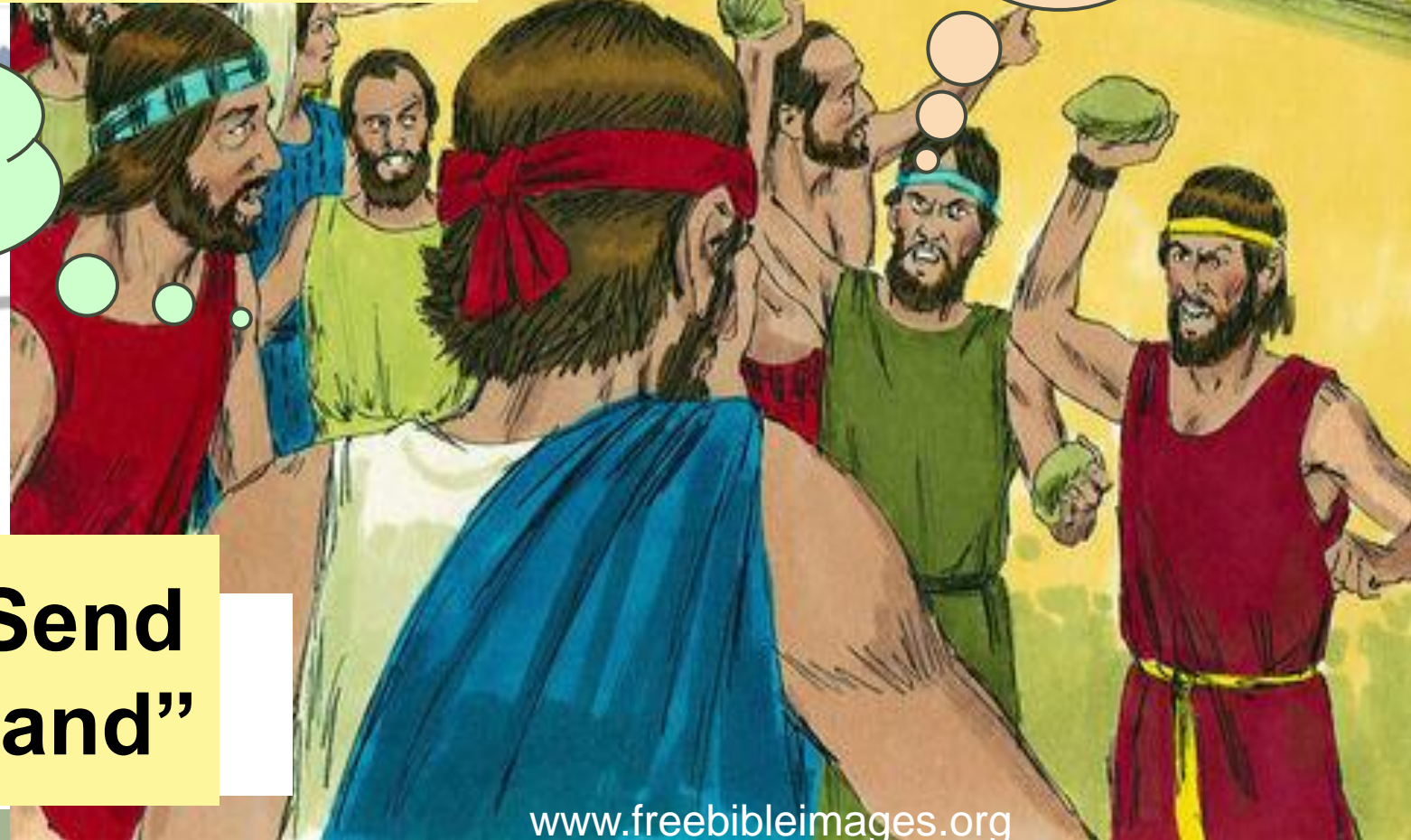
The Rebellion

Moses' Punishment

“Now Moses was a very humble man, more humble than anyone else on the face of the earth” -Num 12:3-



“there was no water...the people... quarreled... 7 The LORD said to Moses, “Take the staff... Speak to that rock before their eyes...” 10... Moses said... “you rebels, must we bring you water out of this rock?” and... struck the rock twice with his staff. Water gushed out... 12 But the LORD said ... “Because you did not trust in me enough to honor me as holy in the sight of the Israelites**, you will not bring them into the land...” Num 20:2-12.**
