Some Prayers ...

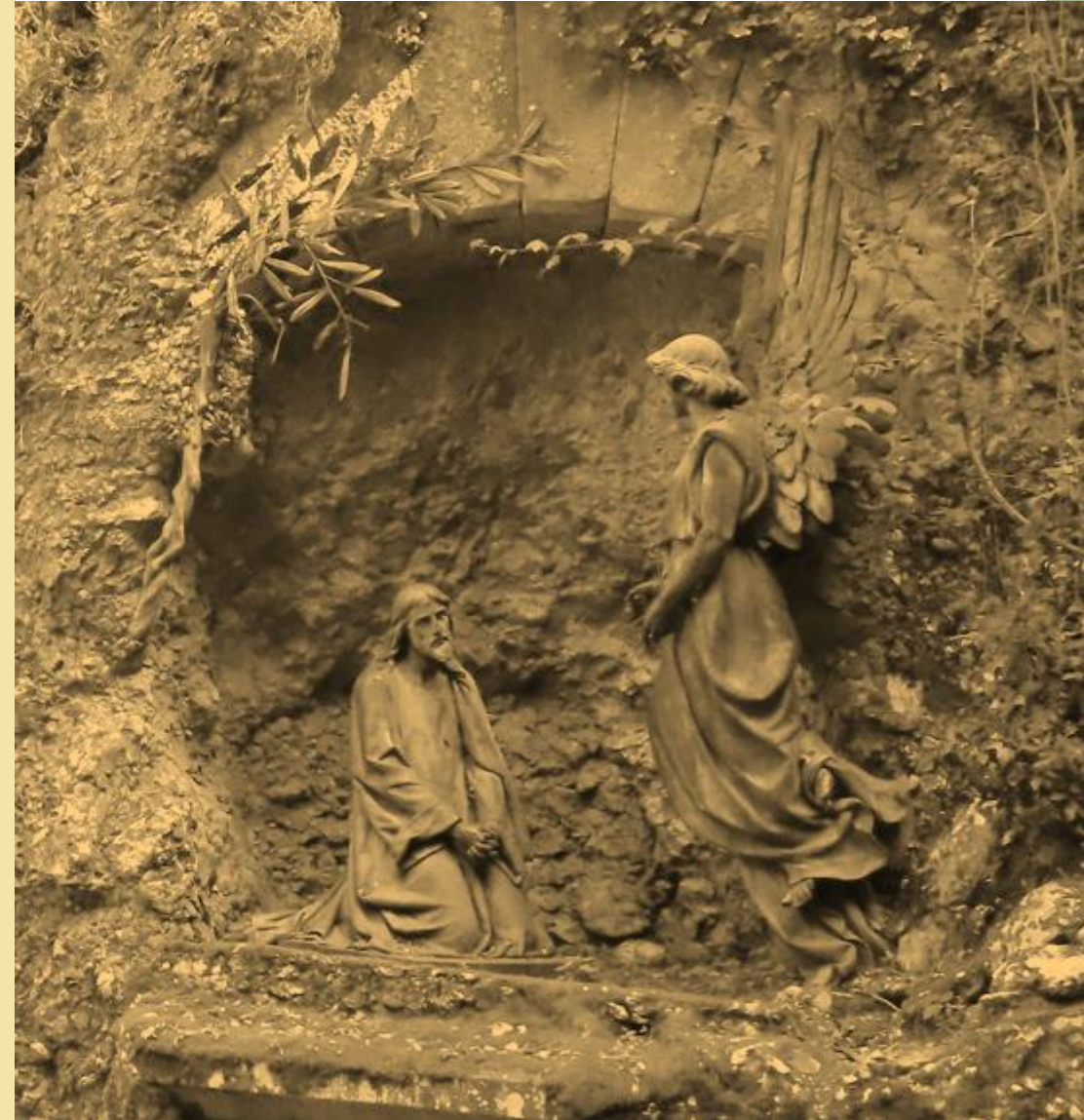
“...Jacob left Beersheba and set out for Harran ...had a dream ...saw a stairway ...with its top reaching to heaven...
