## **Matthew 2:1–3**

**After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi from the east came to Jerusalem 2 and asked, “Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews? We saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him.” 3 When King Herod heard this he was disturbed, and all Jerusalem with him...**

## **Matthew 2:10–12**

**10 When they saw the star, they were overjoyed. 11 On coming to the house, they saw the child with his mother Mary, and they bowed down and worshiped him.**

**Then they opened their treasures and presented him with gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh 12 And having been warned in a dream not to go back to Herod, they returned to their country by another route.**

# The Magi Visit the Messiah...



“Magi [mā-jī] (Μάγοι, singular μάγος = Latin magus from the Persian magu, “astrologer”): the “wise men” from the East who visited Jesus in his infancy”

“despite medieval tradition, they are unidentified, unnamed, and unnumbered”

# Who is Jesus?

**Jesus:** “The Greek form (Ἰησοῦς) of the Hebrew Joshua (יְהוֹשֻׁעַ; lit. ‘**Yahweh saves**’)”

**Christ:** “χριστός, translating the Hebrew מְשִׁיחַ, i.e. (God’s) **Messiah or anointed one**”

# Names of Jesus

**Immanuel:** “God with us” Matt 1:23

**Word:** “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God Jn 1:1

**King of Kings:** “On his robe... this name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS” Rev 19:16

**Rabbi:** “Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher” Jn 3:2

**Prophet:** “...surely no prophet can die outside Jerusalem!” Luke 13:33



# Names of Jesus

**Alpha and Omega:**

**“It is done... I am... the Beginning and the End” Rev 21:6**

**Redeemer :**

**“...Christ Jesus, 6 who gave himself as a ransom for all people” 1 Tim 2:5-6**

**High Priest:**

**“...Jesus, whom we acknowledge as our apostle and high priest” Heb 3:1**

**Lamb of God:**

**“Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world” Jn 1:29**

# John the Baptist

**“I will send my messenger ahead of you, who will prepare your way” 3 “a voice of one calling in the wilderness, ‘Prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for him” Mk 1:2–3**

**“After me [John] comes the one more powerful than I, the straps of whose sandals I am not worthy to stoop down and untie... he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit.”**

**Mk 1:7–8.**

**“At that time Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan” Mk 1:9**

# Jesus' Teaching

**17 From that time on Jesus began to preach, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near.”**

**Mt 4:17**

**The time has come,” he said. “The kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe the good news!**

**Mk 1:15**

**Very truly I tell you [**Ἀμὴν ἀμὴν λέγω σοι**], no one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit **Jn 3:5.****

## **Peter Follows Jesus**

**“About 17,000 people visit  
Vatican City daily”**

**“as Jesus was walking by the Sea of Galilee, He saw two brothers, Simon who was called Peter, and Andrew his brother... they were fishermen... He said... “Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men.” 20 Immediately they left their nets and followed Him. Mt 4:18–20**

**“...you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it. 19 I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven” Mt 16:18–19**

# The Inner Circle

- **Simon Peter:** “The most prominent of the Twelve... his nickname Peter (Greek: Petros) means “rock,”... entrusted with the “keys” of the kingdom... denied Jesus three times... afterward restored to leadership”
- **James, Son of Zebedee:** “he and his brother John were fishermen... Jesus gave them the nickname Boanerges, meaning “sons of thunder”... the first of the apostles martyred for his faith.”
- **John, Brother of James:** “Traditionally believed to be the youngest of the Twelve. John, his brother James, and Peter are viewed as Jesus’ closest disciples who accompanied him”

# The Twelve

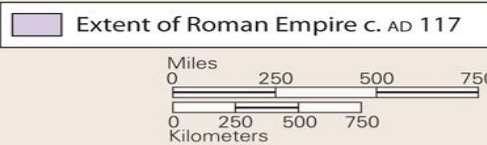
- **Andrew**: Brother of Simon Peter, a follower of John the Baptist
- **Philip**: introduced Nathanael to Jesus
- **Bartholomew**: means “son of Tolmai,” was speculated that he is the same as the man, Nathanael.
- **Matthew**: identified as the tax collector called Levi...
- **Thomas**: called Didymus... known as the disciple who doubted Jesus’ resurrection until he saw and touched Jesus himself... later known to evangelize eastward into India.

# The Twelve

- **James the Son of Alphaeus**: identified as James the Lesser
- **Thaddaeus** (or Judas the Son of James): most disputed name.
- **Simon the Zealot**: unclear if Simon was merely zealous for Judaism or whether he was part of a Zealot movement advocating the violent overthrow of the Romans.
- **Judas Iscariot** (Who Betrayed Him): as treasurer, he used to pilfer the group's money

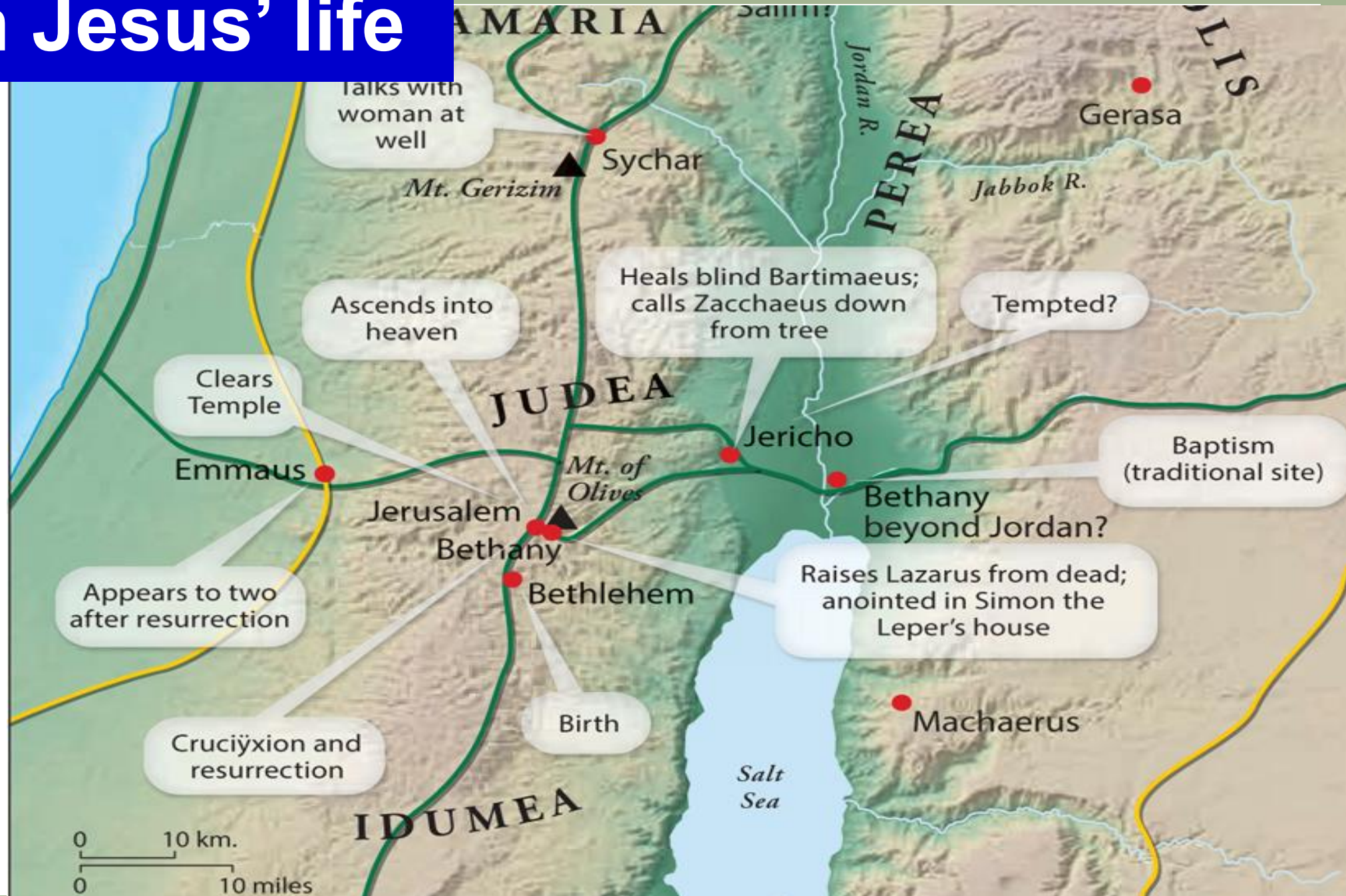
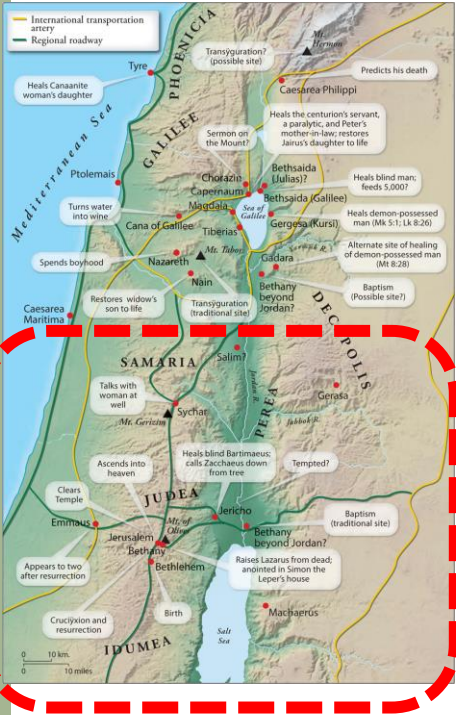
