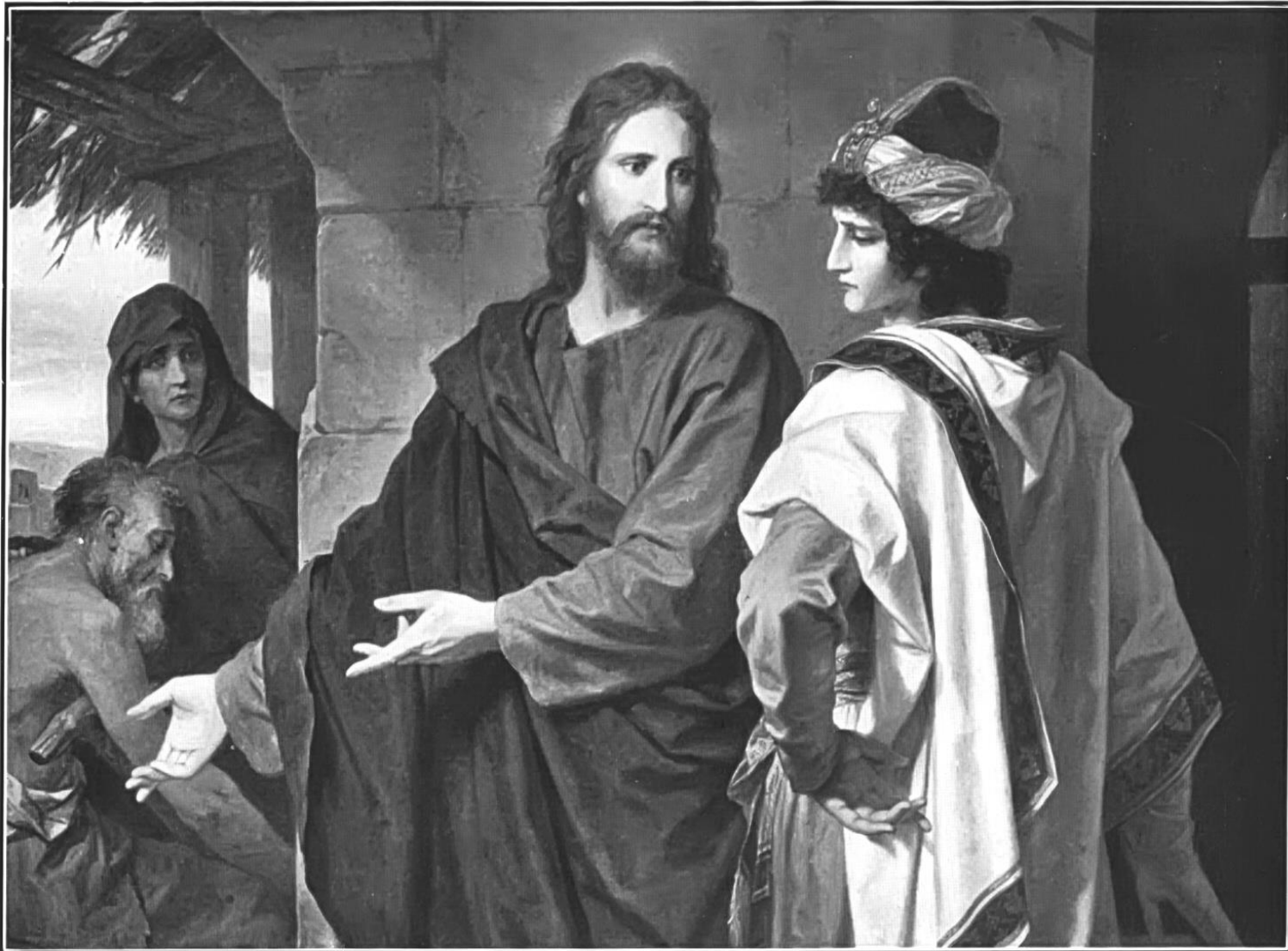

Synecdoche

"Man shall not live on bread alone, but on... every word that comes from the mouth of God"

Jesus' "Figures of Speech"

Hyperbole

"It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God"

Pun

"And I tell you that you are Peter [petros], and on this rock [petra] I will build my church"

Other...

"if anyone strikes you on the right cheek, turn the other also..."

“And whoever welcomes one such child in my name welcomes me” Mt 18:5

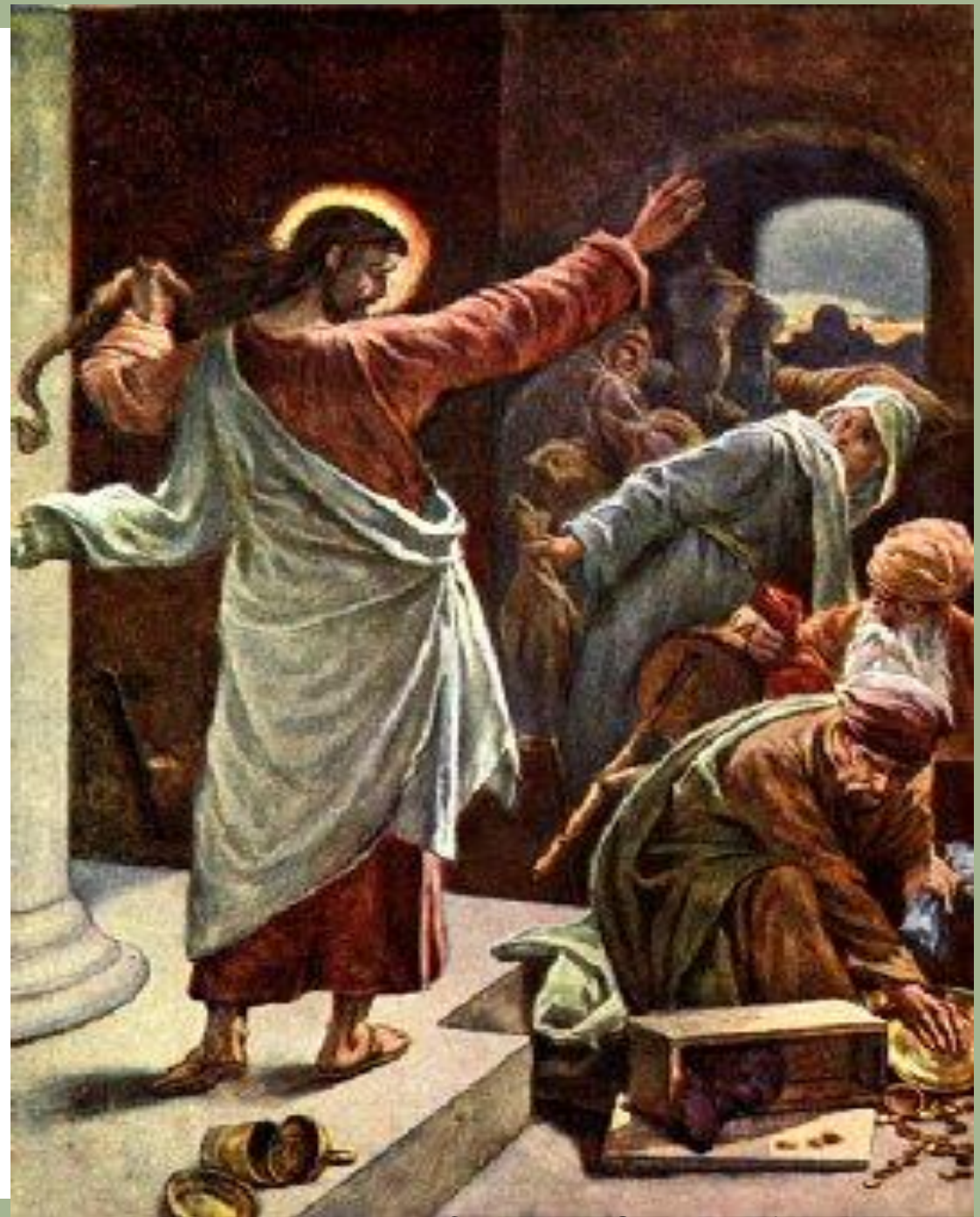
Miracle Worker & Healer

'7 Woes' in Matthew 23

13 "Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You shut the door of the kingdom of heaven..."

15 "Woe to you... you hypocrites! You travel over... to win a single convert... make them twice as much a child of hell as you are"

16 "Woe to you, blind guides! You say, 'If anyone swears by the temple, it means nothing; but ... by the gold of the temple is bound by that oath..."

23 "Woe to you... hypocrites! You give a tenth of your spices... But... neglected ... justice, mercy... faithfulness"

‘7 Woes’ in Matthew 23

25 “Woe to you... hypocrites! You clean the outside of the cup... but inside they are full of greed...”

27 “Woe to you... hypocrites! You are like whitewashed tombs, which look beautiful on the outside but on the inside are full of... everything unclean”

29 “Woe to you... hypocrites! You build tombs for the prophets and decorate the graves of the righteous”

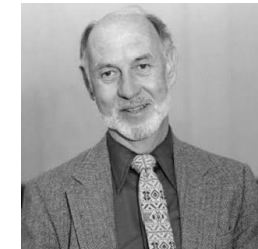
33 “You snakes! You brood of vipers! How will you escape being condemned to hell?”

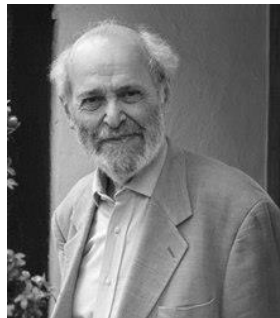


Professor emeritus in early Christianity at the Claremont School of Theology in Claremont
