Origin of Thanksgiving

“In 1621, the Plymouth colonists from England and the Native American Wampanoag people shared an autumn harvest feast that is acknowledged as one of the first Thanksgiving celebrations in the colonies”

“Some argue that Florida may have been the true site of the first Thanksgiving... In 1565, a Spanish fleet came ashore and planted a cross in the sandy beach to name the new settlement of St. Augustine. The 800 Spanish settlers shared a festive meal with the native Timucuan people”

Pilgrims with Mayflower...

“Mayflower... transported a group of English families... the Pilgrims ... with 102 passengers and a crew of about 30... dropping anchor near the tip of Cape Cod, MA, on Nov. 21, 1620”



“Differing from their contemporaries, the Puritans (who sought to reform and purify the Church of England), the Pilgrims chose to separate themselves from them... In 1608, a group of English families left for the Netherlands, where they could worship freely. By 1620... determined to cross the Atlantic for America... a "new Promised Land”

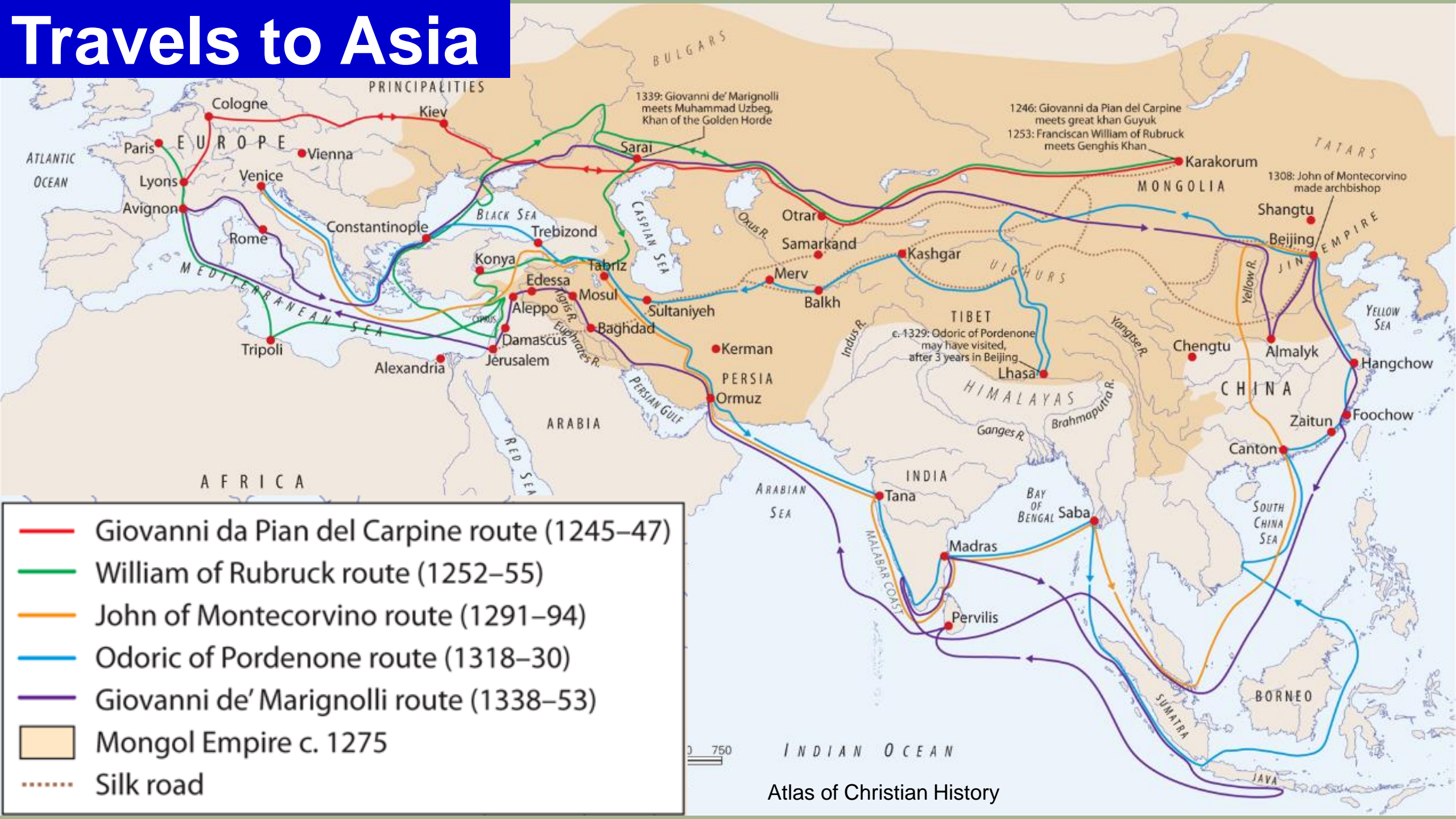
“Portuguese founded the port of Elmina on the Gold Coast at Ghana in 1482, beginning slave trade”

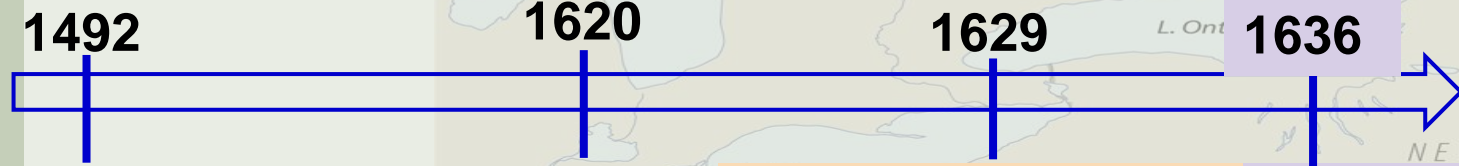
“Italian sailor John Cabot, in 1497, visited Canada, became the first recorded European voyager to land in North America”

The Great Migration



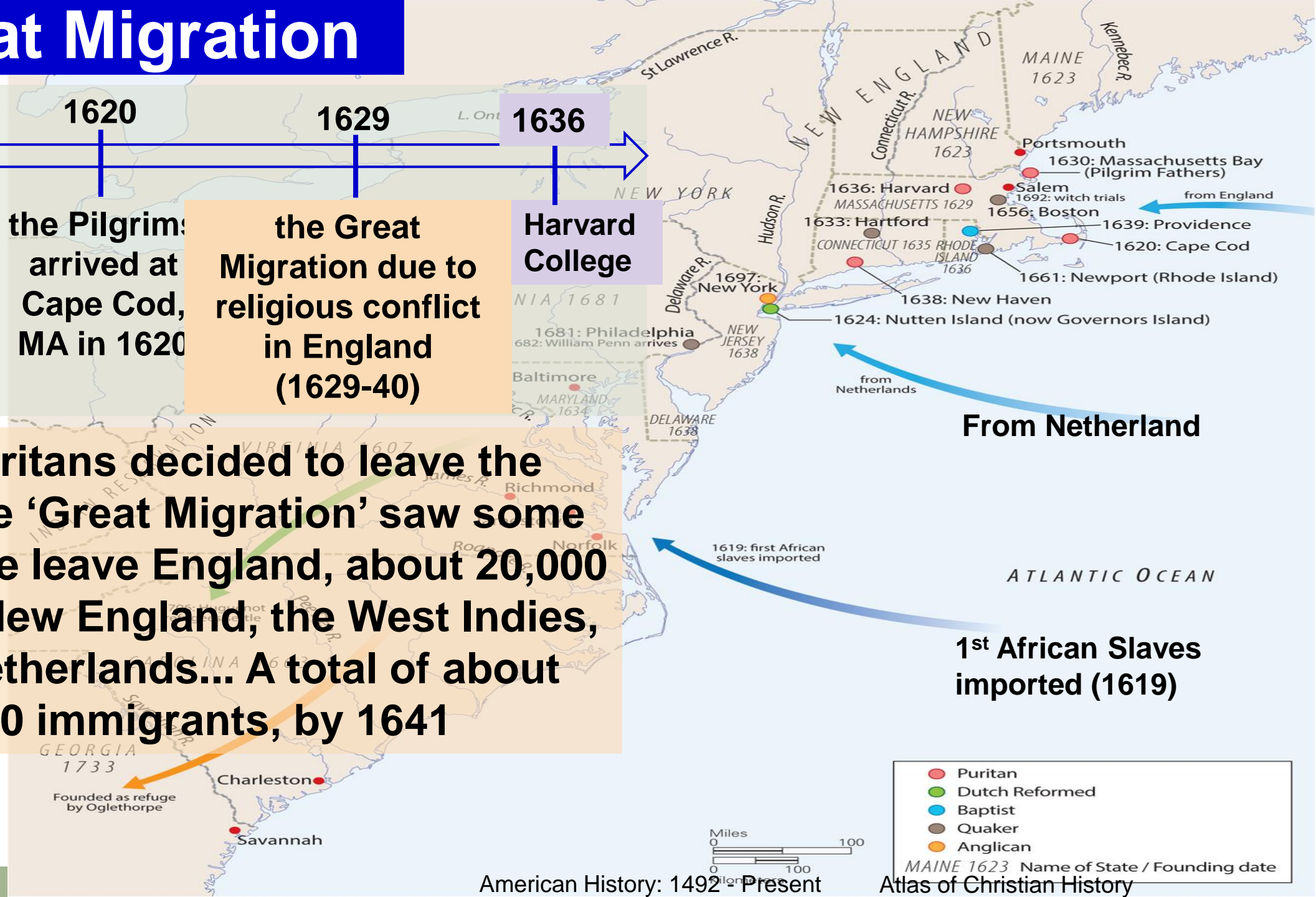
Columbus

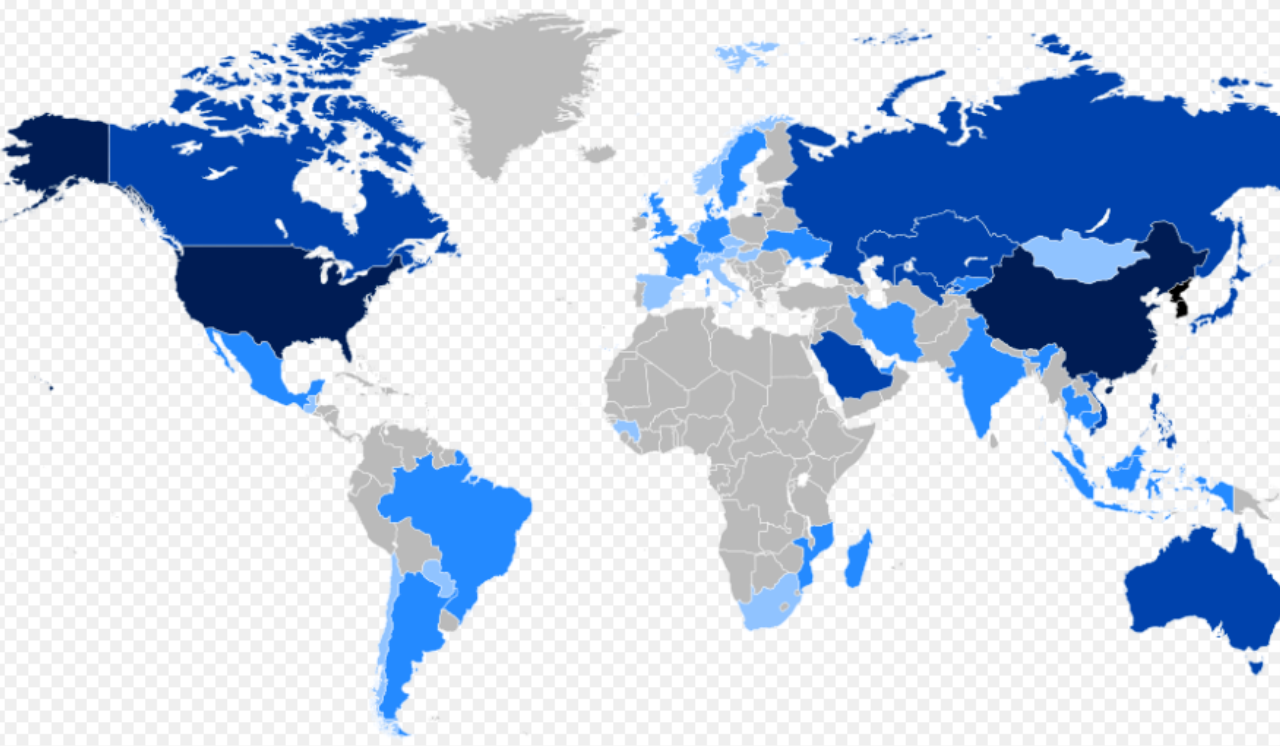

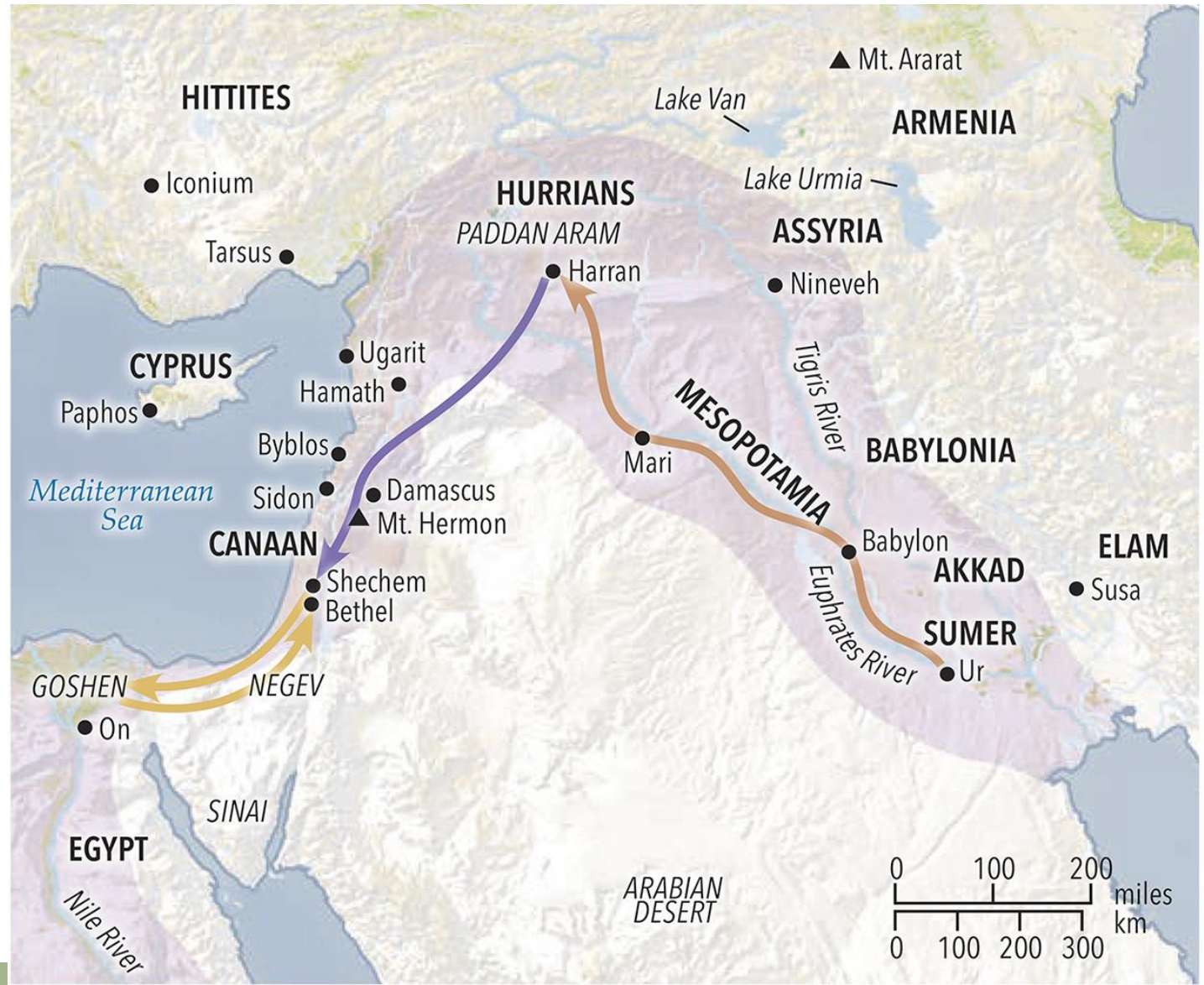
