"The Magnificat"

"the Magnificat (The Song of Mary) means "magnifies" or "praises"—is the first word in the traditional Latin translation"

"And Mary said: "My soul glorifies the Lord 47 and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior, 48 for he has been mindful of the humble state of his servant. From now on all generations will call me blessed, 49 for the Mighty One has done great things for me— holy is his name..."

"The Benedictus"

"the song of Zechariah is the counterpart of The Magnificat- known by the first word of its Latin translation, Benedictus, "blessed."

"[John]'s father Zechariah was filled with the Holy Spirit ... Praise be to the Lord, the God of Israel, because he has come to his people and redeemed them. 69 He has raised up a horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David ... 72 to show mercy to our ancestors and to remember his holy covenant... to... Abraham"


