Genesis 42:1–7

1 When Jacob learned that there was grain in Egypt, he said to his sons, “Why do you just keep looking at each other?” 2 He continued, “I have heard that there is grain in Egypt. Go down there and buy some for us, so that we may live and not die.” 3 Then ten of Joseph’s brothers went down to buy grain from Egypt. 4 But Jacob did not send Benjamin, Joseph’s brother, with the others, because he was afraid that harm might come to him.

5 So Israel's sons were among those who went to buy grain, for there was famine in the land of Canaan also. 6 Now Joseph was the governor of the land, the person who sold grain to all its people. So when Joseph's brothers arrived, they bowed down to him with their faces to the ground. 7 As soon as Joseph saw his brothers, he recognized them, but he pretended to be a stranger and spoke harshly to them. "Where do you come from?" he asked

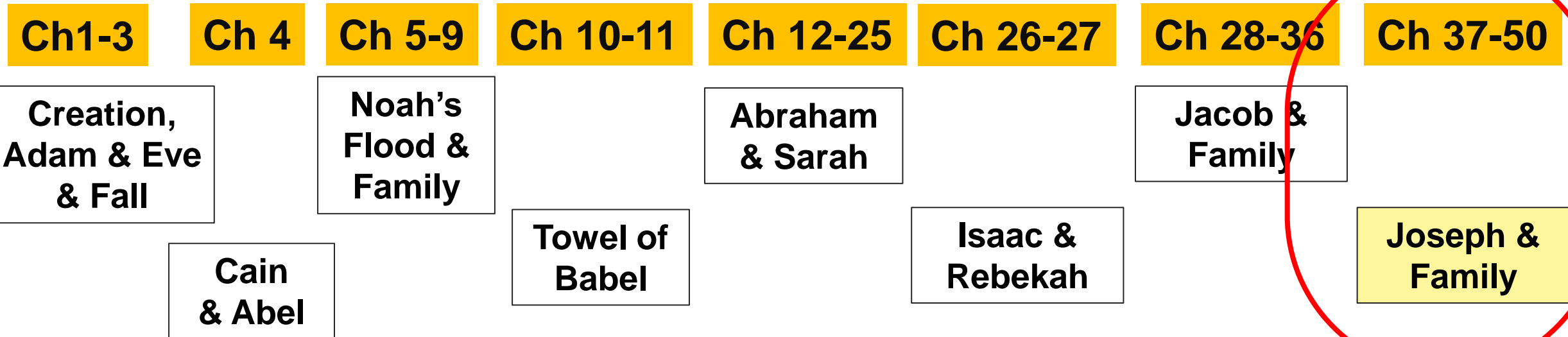
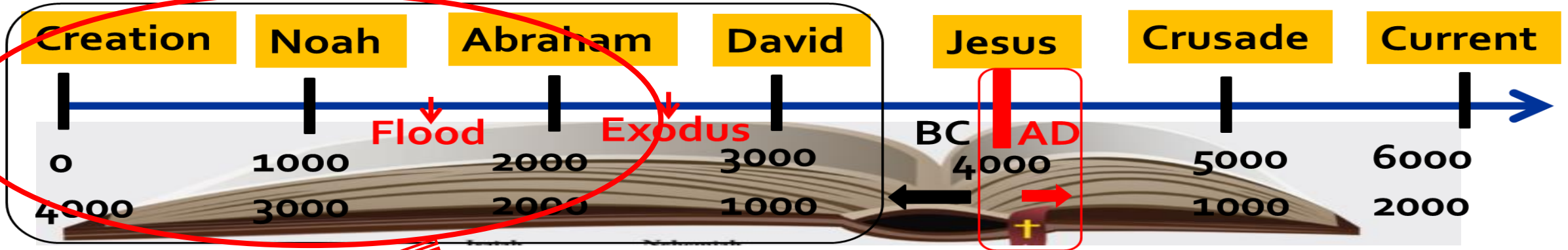

The Famine Spreads...

“Joseph was the governor ...who sold grain to all its people... Joseph’s brothers arrived... bowed down to him ...Joseph ...recognized them, but ...pretended to be a stranger ...“Where do you come from?” he asked. “From the land of Canaan” ...8 Although Joseph recognized ...they did not ...he remembered his dreams about them...

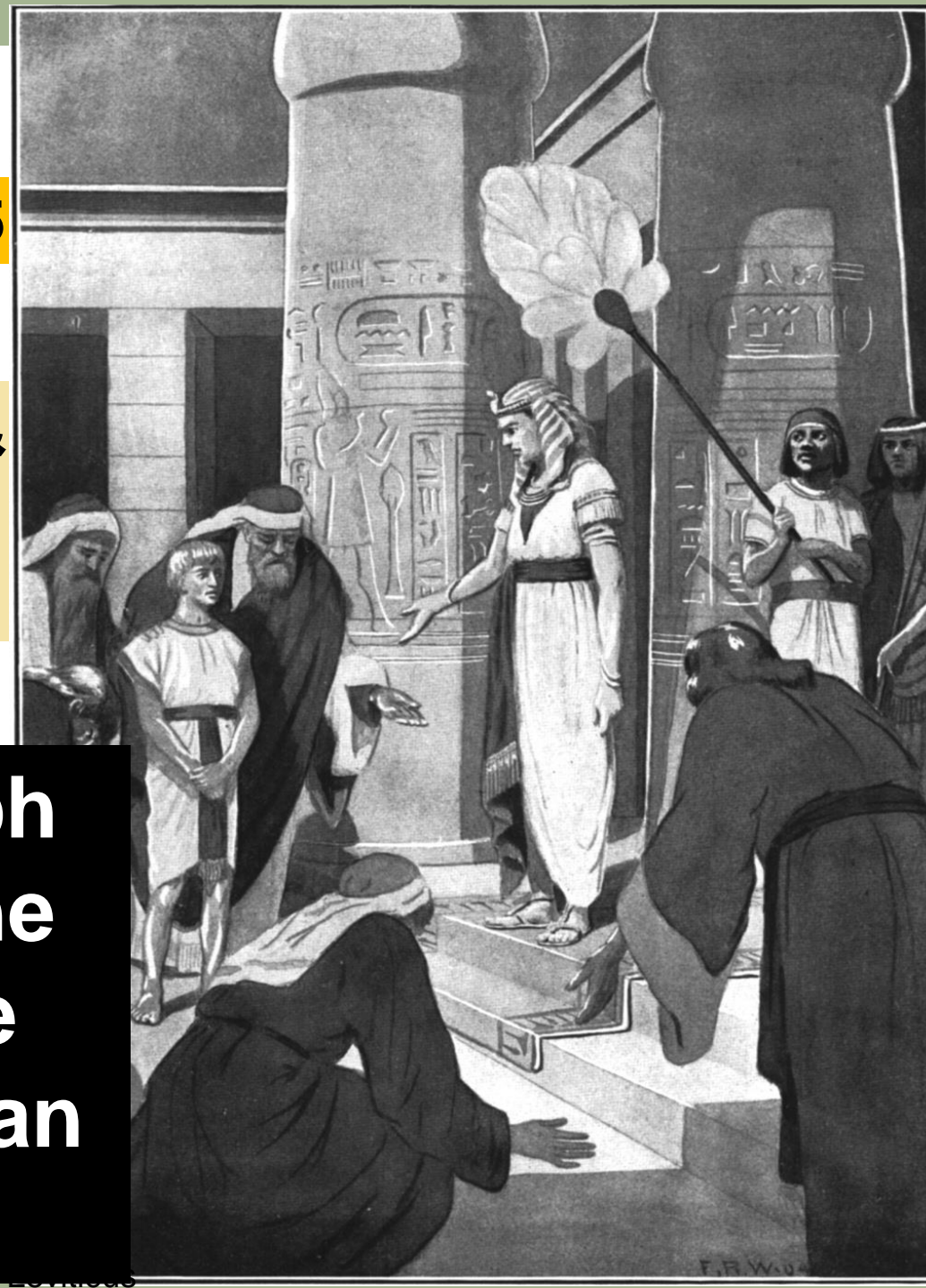
“You are spies! You have come to see where our land is unprotected.”
10 “No, my lord... “Your servants have come to buy food” -Gen 42:6–10-



The Brothers Tested...

“this is how you will be tested...let one of your brothers stay here...the rest ... take grain & back ... But you must bring your youngest brother ... so that your words may be verified ...”

“They did not realize that Joseph could understand them, since he was using an interpreter. 24 He turned away from them and began to weep...” -Gen 42:23-24-



Second Test...

“Joseph gave orders to put their bags with grain, to each man’s silver back sack ...27 At the place where they stopped for the night, one of them opened his sack and saw his silver in it.

“Deeply moved at the sight of his brother, Joseph hurried out and looked for a place to weep... 31 After he had washed his face, he came out...” -Gen 42:23-24-

“...they came to their father Jacob ... told him all... But Jacob said, “My son will not go down there ...his brother is dead and he is the only one left...

the famine was still severe ...they had eaten all the grain...

They hurried down to Egypt ...When Benjamin with them, he said to them, “Take these silver pieces...prepare a meal... I saw his brother and I said, ‘This is your youngest son.’” -Gen 42:29–21-

Second Test...

“Isn’t this the cup my master drinks ...? This is a wicked thing you have done... they said... “Far be it from your servants to do anything like that!... Whoever is found to have it will become my slave... And the cup was found in Benjamin’s sack... they tore their clothes ...returned to the city... Joseph was still in the house when ...his brothers came in... threw themselves to the ground before him ” -Gen 44:5–14-

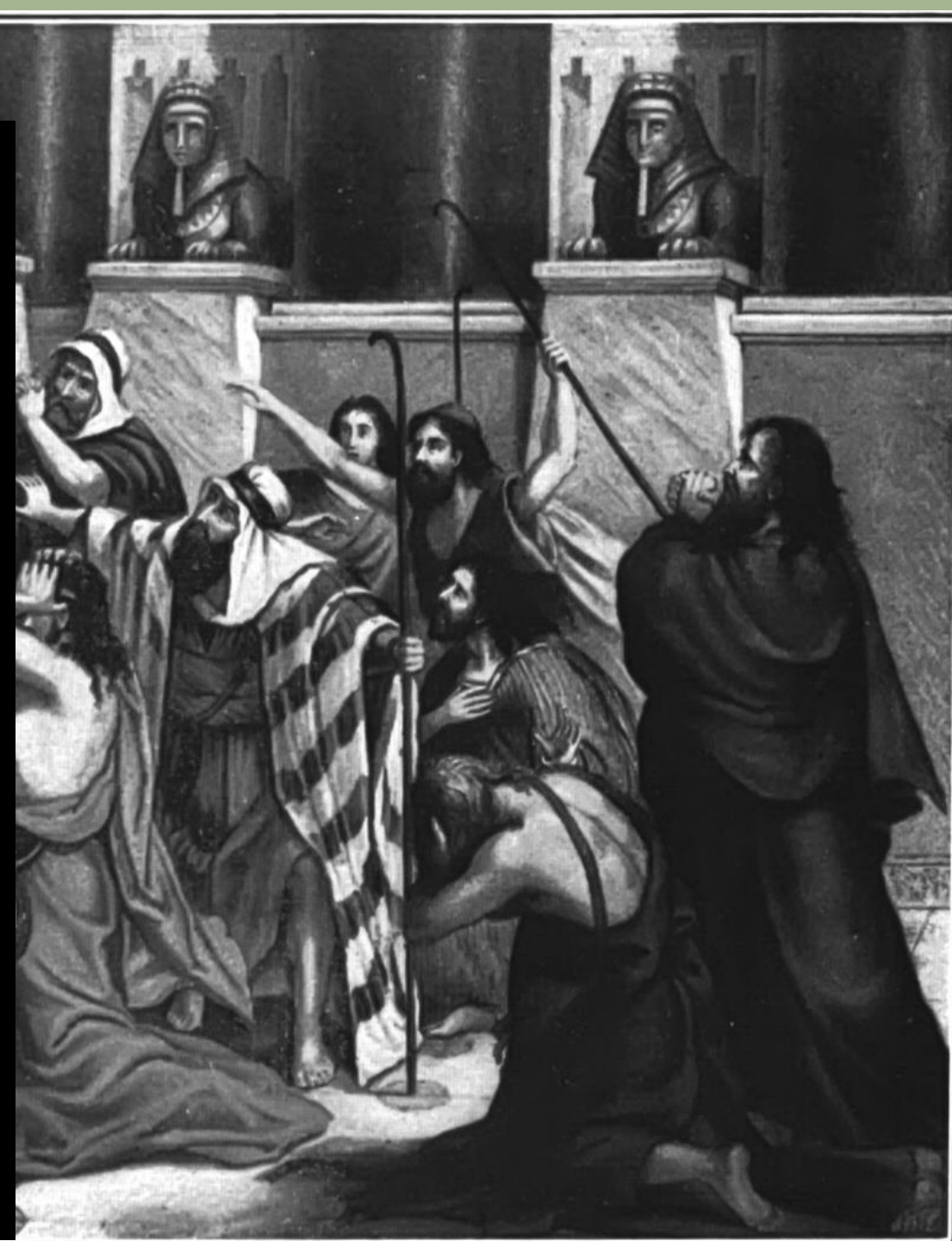


Second Test...

“Then Joseph could no longer control himself ... “Have everyone leave my presence!”

...And he wept so loudly that the Egyptians heard him...

“I am Joseph! ... his brothers were ...terrified ... do not be angry with yourselves for selling me here... it was to save lives that God sent me ahead of you” -Gen 45:1-5-
