Genesis 11:1-9

1 Now the whole world had one language and a common speech. 2 As people moved eastward, they found a plain in Shinar and settled there. 3 They said to each other, “Come, let’s make bricks and bake them thoroughly.” They used brick instead of stone, and tar for mortar. 4 Then they said, “Come, let us build ourselves a city, with a tower that reaches to the heavens, so that we may make a name for ourselves; otherwise we will be scattered over the face of the whole earth.” 5 But the LORD came down to see the city and the tower the people were building.





Power of Dust... ? (smaller than 2 mm)




VIOLENT VOLCANOES




- 1816 is known as the Year Without a Summer -




The World After the Flood

The world following the Flood was not as stable as before. For at least several hundred years, volcanic eruptions and earthquakes were common, and weather patterns were severe and erratic.

This world-wide instability resulted in the "Ice Age."


Causes of an "Ice Age"

Conditions needed for snow and ice to accumulate:

1. extensive evaporation from oceans;
2. extended snowfall;
3. reduced snow melt.

All of these would result from the Flood of Noah's day.

Causes of Ice Age



Warmer Oceans

The oceans before the Flood were warmer than today. During the Flood, much heat was added to the oceans from the "fountains of the great deep" and geologic upheavals. This would cause greater evaporation.

Colder Continents

Without the former "greenhouse" canopy, the barren lands in the northern latitudes became colder than before. The difference in temperature between ocean and continent would cause intense storm patterns to develop. The result—more snowfall.

Volcanism


As the continents rose, many enormous volcanic episodes would result. Volcanic debris in the atmosphere would shield the earth from much of the sun's warming radiation. Thus much of the extensive snow would not melt in the summer. The "Ice Age" would continue as long as these conditions prevailed, probably from 500 to 1000 years after the Flood.

Worldwide Migration



Worldwide Migration

The green area indicates exposed land resulting from a drop in sea level of several hundred feet due to the "Ice Age." This phenomenon helped to make it possible for man and beast to spread throughout the world as God had commanded.
