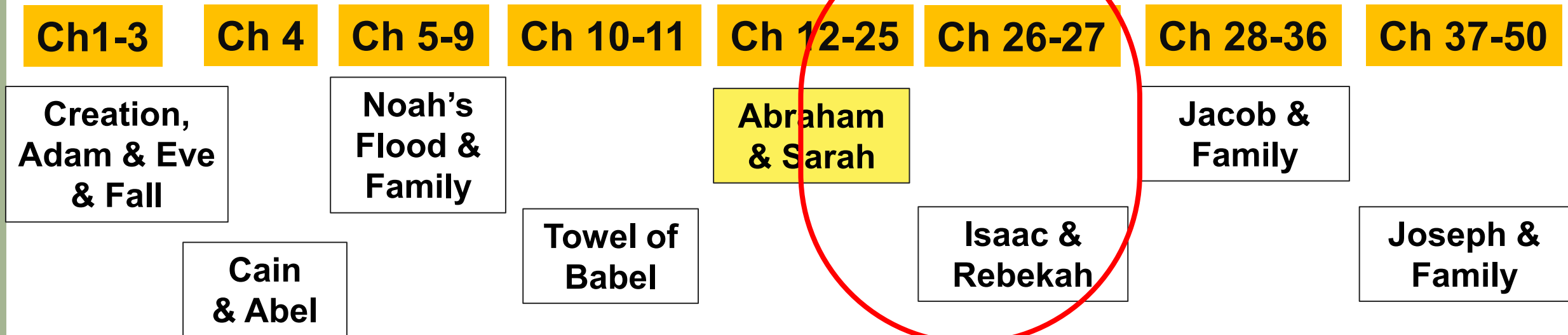
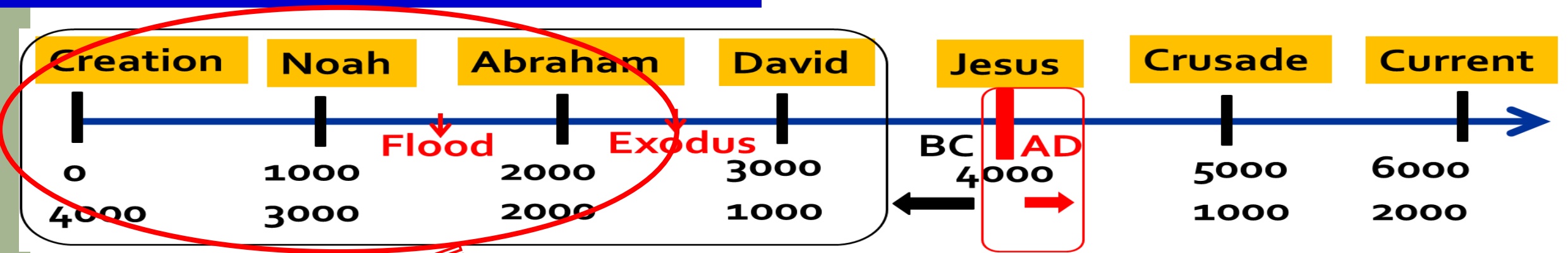

-Sarah died at Hebron when he was 36 years old

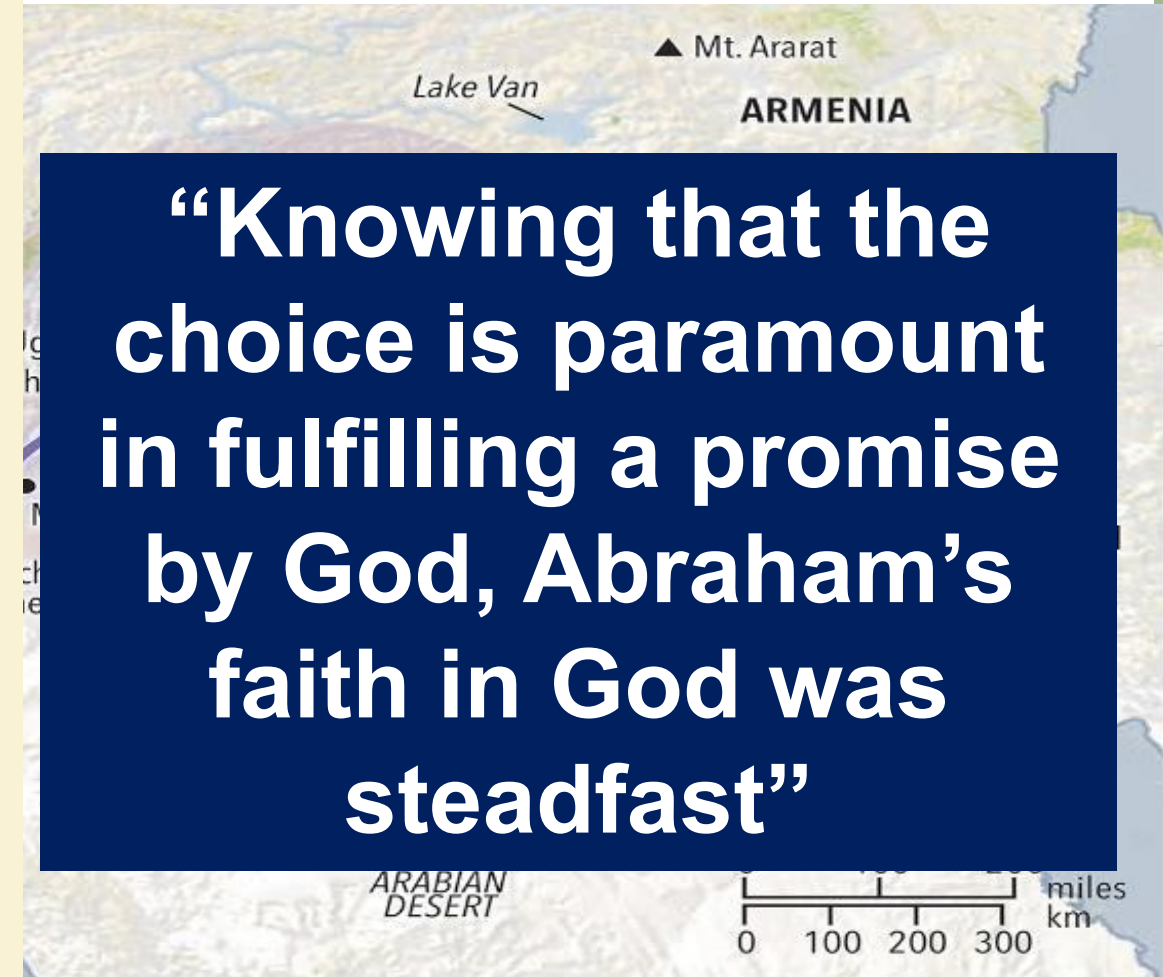
-Abraham sent ‘his servant, to take his wife from his kindred

“15 Before he had finished praying, Rebekah came out with her jar on her shoulder. She was the daughter of Bethuel son of Milkah... the wife of Abraham’s brother Nahor. 16 The woman was very beautiful, a virgin...

17 The servant hurried to meet her ...“Please give me a little water from your jar.” 18 “Drink, my lord,” she said and quickly lowered the jar ...I’ll draw water for your camels too ...the man watched her closely ...” -Ge 24:15–21-



“The servant’s prayer of specificity, believing that God was orchestrating every detail”



His Marriage: “An Answered Prayer”

“When the camels had finished drinking, the man took out a gold nose ring ...two gold bracelets ...Then he asked, “Whose daughter are you? ... 24 She answered ...“I am the daughter of Bethuel, the son that Milkah bore to Nahor.” ... 26 Then the man bowed down and worshiped the LORD ...“Praise be to the LORD, the God of my master Abraham... the LORD has led me ... to the house of my master’s relatives.” -Ge 24:22–28-
