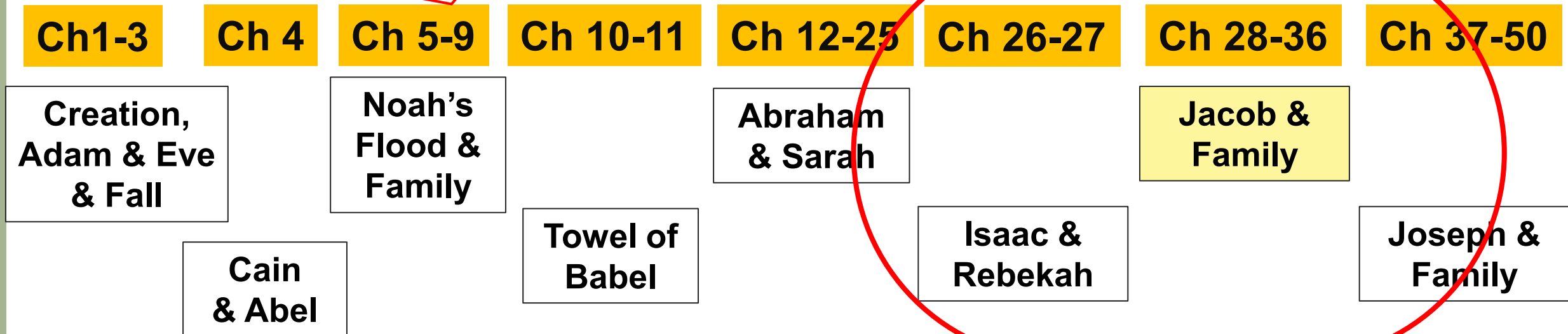
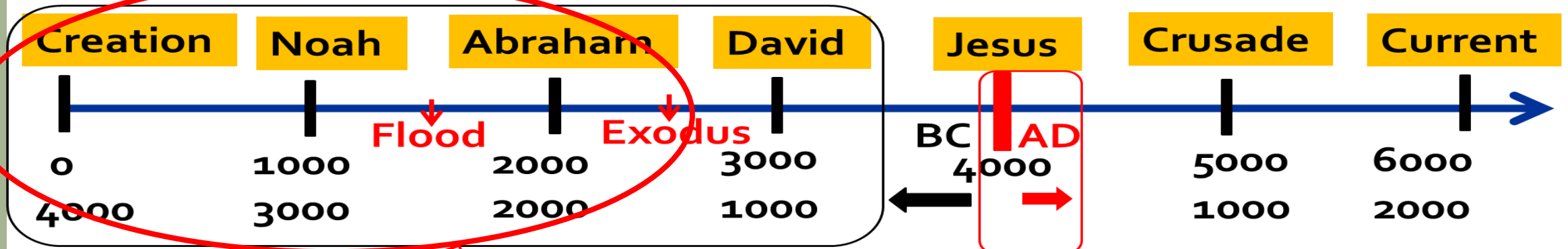
Genesis 25:21–28

“My son... I am now an old man and don't know the day of my death... get your... quiver and bow... to hunt some wild game... Prepare me the kind of tasty food... bring it to me

“...Esau left ...Rebekah said to Jacob...

I overheard your father say ...listen carefully and do what I tell you 9 Go out to the flock and bring me two choice young goats, so I can prepare some tasty food ...just the way he likes it... so that he may give you his blessing...”

 - Rebekah: ...cheated & taught her son to do the same, worshipped her son, distrusted her God...**

Rebekah died without seeing her son again”**
